Remembering William J. Pape II



Waterbury, CT - Kingsbury School has been honored to call our school newspaper "The Pape" named for one of its most distinguished alumni Mr. William J. Pape II. Mr. Pape passed away on April 20, 2019.

William J. Pape II was born on August 14, 1931 in Waterbury, the son of William B. Pape and Helen Cronan Pape. In addition to F.J. Kingsbury School, he graduated from the Naval Academy and Harvard Business School.

As the grandson of the Republican American's founder, William Jamieson Pape, and son of the paper's publisher, William B. Pape, Mr. Pape grew up in the newspaper business.

William J. Pape II saw the Republican American recognized by several awards including the Livingston Award from the University of Michigan for outstanding local reporting.
