SAT and ACT

- Most schools are NOT requiring the SAT or ACT, it is optional.
- The next SAT will be offered March 13th and the deadline to register is February 12th, sign up at www.collegeboard.org
- The ACT will be offered on April 17th and June 12th. The deadline to register for 4/17/21 is 3/12/21. You can sign up or get more information at www.act.org
- Chino Hills is not currently a test center; however, you can view all testing centers on College Board's and ACT's website.

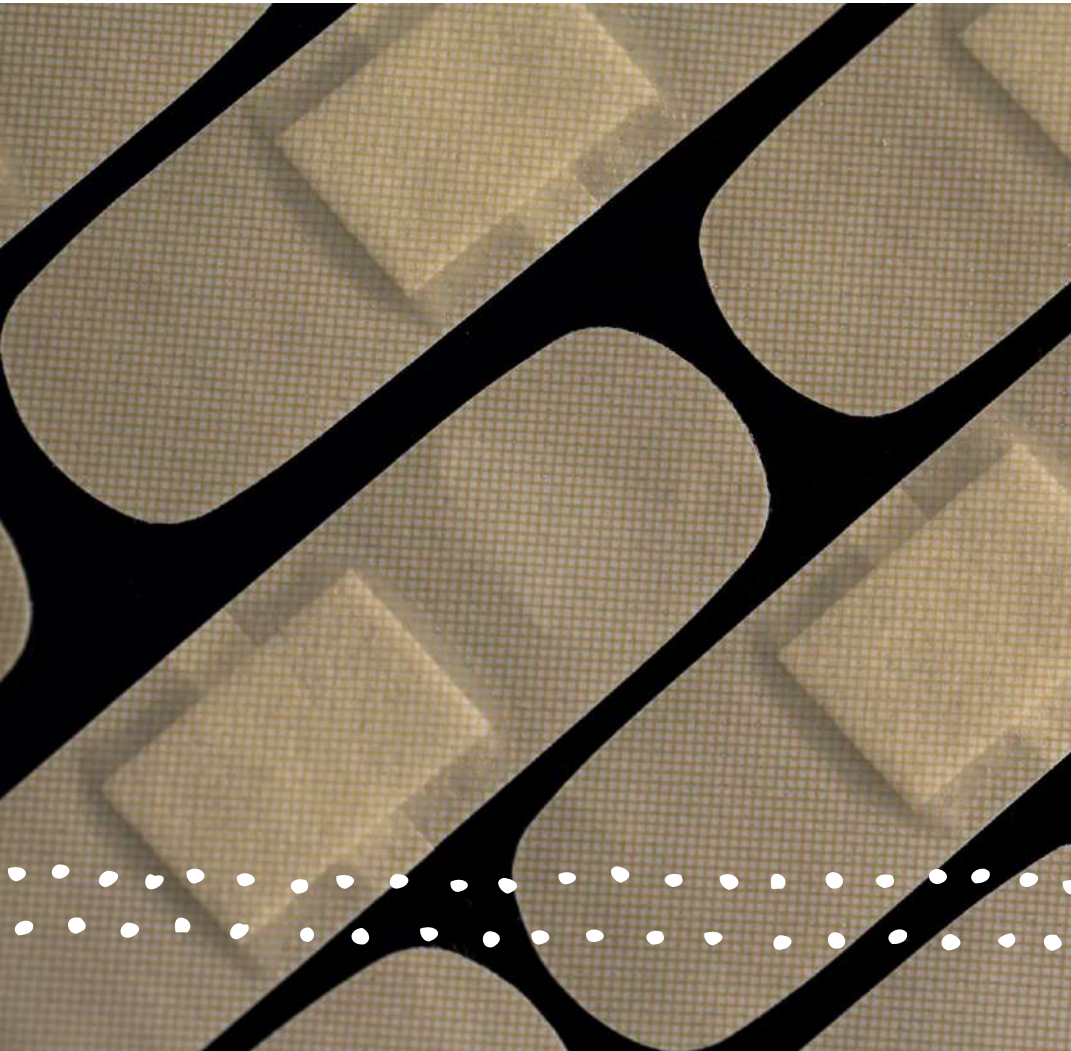
