Expectations for Incoming First Graders

The following skills expectations for incoming 1st graders should be considered as minimum expectations. It is recommended that all students continue to reinforce academic skills during the summer before entering 1st grade, especially in the areas of reading, math, and writing skills.

Reading --Understand that letters represent sounds (phonics) • Know the short and long sound for each vowel, and all the consonants •Decode simple words using letter-sound knowledge * Read all Kindergarten-level sight words

Writing -• Write each letter of the alphabet (upper and lower case) • Write first and last name correctly using capital and lower case letters

Math- • Solve simple addition and subtraction sentences to 10 • Count to 100 • Identify and write numbers to 100

- A full willingness and readiness to learn daily.

- Being able to independently comprehend grade level reading passages.
- The ability to add and subtract numbers within 25 without regrouping.
- Printed handwriting where all alphabets (upper and lower case) are the correct sizing for standard handwriting paper and is legible.

Expectations and Vocabulary

Reading Expectations

- Read fluently and with expression using grade-appropriate material.
- Adequately comprehend written material (stated fact/opinion, identifying the problem, context clues, predicting, inference, etc.)
- Apply phonetic rules when reading and spelling.
- Understand and apply basic spelling rules.

Writing

- Write in complete sentences with correct capitalization and punctuation.
- Speak and write using correct grammar (nouns, verbs, verb tense, etc.)
- Be able to organize ideas into clear, complete sentences.
- Have a basic understanding of how to elaborate (more details, adjectives, adverbs, etc.)
- Understand that writing should be done in time order or a logical sequence of events.
- Correct formation of all upper and lower case letters when forming manuscript and cursive letters.

Math

- Know multiplication facts by memory.
- Know how to add and subtract with regrouping.
- Have a basic understanding of place value through the hundreds place.
- Applies problem-solving strategies to solve word problems.
- Basic understanding of telling times and counting money.
