Job Description

Objective of the Instructional Facilitator:

An Instructional Facilitator is responsible for providing classroom instructional support across subject areas and grade levels. Position objectives include: goal setting, co-planning, and co-teaching with individual teachers, small groups of teachers, and grade-level teams to focus on student learning and evidence-based practices. An Instructional Facilitator will provide support through the collection, analysis, and interpretation of multiple data sources to directly impact teaching and learning. The instructional facilitator will also be responsible for weekly planning meetings with campus principals and district coaches.

Foster and support a culture of teacher leaders in a non-evaluative setting

Facilitate and collaborate with teachers on designing, planning, and implementing standards-based units of study that focus on developing students as active participants in the learning process

Collaborate in the development of a system to collect and analyze student data

Facilitate ongoing analysis of data to identify student learning goals and guide instructional practices

Support implementation of state mandated curriculum and instruction guidelines

Assist in the selection/implementation of instructional materials, professional learning while supporting the district's vision of teaching and learning
