

## There has never been a better time to be part of the Ramsey School District!

Our facilities are getting more than \$43 million in major upgrades to support our curricular and extracurricular ambitions and ultimately our students' success.

Most of the projects are funded by the 2018 voter-approved bond referendum, which enables the district to take advantage of more than \$10 million in state aid to help cover costs. More good news for homeowners: When the Dater School loan is paid off in 2024, they'll soon see the tax impact of our school improvement projects significantly drop by about \$240 for a home assessed at Ramsey's average.

#### We are a Learning Community

- Ramsey's rigorous curriculum prepares our students to excel, and outcomes such as high test scores and college admissions prove the value of our approach.
- Our comprehensive mental health program, our social-emotional learning initiatives, and our commitment to equity are among the ways we foster an environment where all students can thrive.
- Design Thinking course, unique to Ramsey, requires collaboration to tackle complex problems in creative ways.
- Teaching for Understanding framework used by teachers puts emphasis on what students can do with what they know.
- Profile Projects completed in grades 3, 5, and 8 challenge students to apply what they have learned and build key competencies. Grade 12 students reflect on their growth with Defense of Learning presentations, common in colleges but rare in high schools.
- More than 90% of RHS students participate in our extensive complement of musical, artistic, athletic, literary, dramatic, social, cultural and service opportunities.
