### **Reading**

Our reading program is produced by National Geographic called Reach For Reading (R4R). R4R uses many texts with social studies and science themes.

I use the Daily Five Structure, giving the students purposeful tasks to work on individually and in pairs, while I provide skill-specific coaching and conferencing to students.

### Writing



For writing, we will learn to write in three styles: narrative, informational and opinion. The style of writing changes each quarter, while building on the strategies learned from previous quarters.

### What do we learn in 1st Grade?

#### Math



Our math curriculum is Origio Stepping Stones. The program is aligned with Common Core Standards and exposes students to a wide variety of math concepts and strategies. Look for monthly newsletters explaining the standards being taught for each unit.

#### **Science**

Our science program is called STEMScopes. STEM stands for science, technology, engineering and math. With this program, students will be involved in several group projects that teach them about scientists, engineers, and the around them.

#### **Social Studies**

Our Reach for Reading curriculum touches on social studies themes throughout the year. We will also learn about various holidays and traditions. A large part of social studies is learning to be caring friends in class and school and working together as a class community.
