Who do I contact if:

- I am struggling in several classes? *Teachers/Counselors/Academic Trackers/Homework Club*
- I have had a serious event in my life that is causing me difficulty like (death in the family, depression, physical conditions, or major injury) *Counselors/Teachers/Administrators/Academic Trackers/Student Support Center*
- I have concerns about accommodations for a medical condition? *Administration/Counselors/Nursing Services*

Frequently Asked Questions continued:

Who do I contact if:

- I have been bullied, harassed, or threatened at school? At home? *Counselors/Administration*
- I learn about a crime that took place in the school, or potential physical harm or suicide threat? *Counselors/Administration*
- I feel anxious, overwhelmed or depressed? *Teachers/Counselors*
- I am not making friends or having problems with friends? *Counselors/Teachers/Administrators*

If you don't know who to contact, start with the counselors.

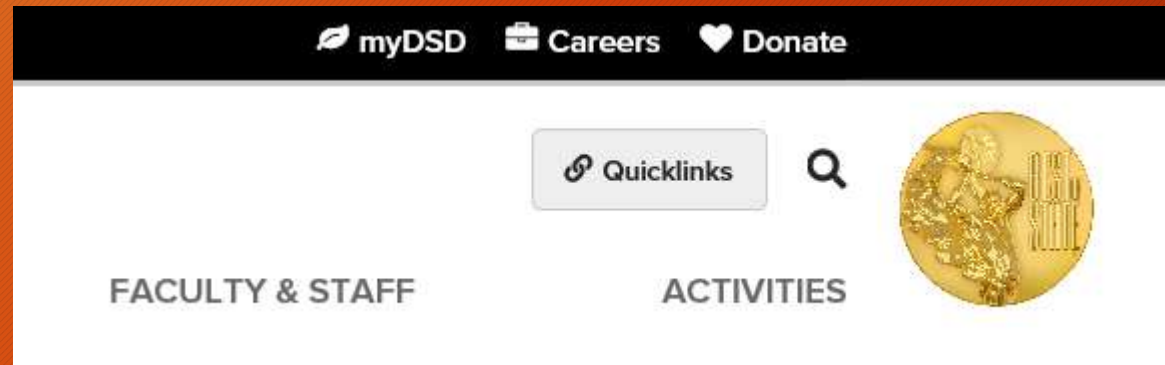
