



When you enter the virtual meeting, **mute yourself** (*if you aren't already*). Your teacher will tell you when to unmute when it's your turn to speak.

When you have a burning question, type it in the **chat box**. Your teacher will tell you when to unmute so that you can ask your question.

Ask your teacher if your camera should be turned on or off. If it's on, check to make sure the lighting is good so everyone can see you. Look into the camera when you are talking.




ETIQUETTE

## State Assessments! We Will Need Your Help!

Even though the students are doing Online Learning, we still need to assess them, as required by the State. So it is very important that the homework is done **only** by the student, not by others in the family. Photos of the homework must be emailed to Ms. Uribe. Some of the assessment will be done during our live meetings, and by videos made by the parents. We will give instructions later. Don't worry, they will be easy activities, such as videos of your child hopping on one foot, running and kicking a ball, throwing and catching a ball, writing with a pencil or crayon, and having conversations with others in English or Spanish.

#### When In the Classroom/Back in school /CHILD ILLNESS AND HEALTH POLICY

Teachers are required to check each student for signs of illness.

Parent will be required to remain at the center while the teacher conducts a daily health check.

Child can be sent home or excluded from school when:

\*Temperature of 100 degrees or above

\*Diarrhea/Cough and/or a hard, raspy or barking cough/Unexplained rashes

\*Vomiting /Yellow, green and/or unclear nasal discharge or mucus from eyes (Pink eye must have a doctor's note to return to school.)

Head lice, the child cannot return to the preschool until the child is lice and nit free

and has been checked by site health personnel.

Child must be free of illness 24 hours without medication to return to school until he/she is symptom free for 24 hours and/or has been seen by a doctor.




## Navigating Classroom
