- ❖ - Susan's family owned Dred Scott as a slave.
- ❖ - Susan ran a school for 11 years without any pay.
- ❖ - In September 1873, Susan opened the first public school in Des Peres school.
- ❖ - Susan retired in 1884.
- ❖ - Susan is buried in Bellefontaine cemetery.

- ❖ - She went to Germany and met Frederick Froebel who had a kindergarten class and she took notes there.
