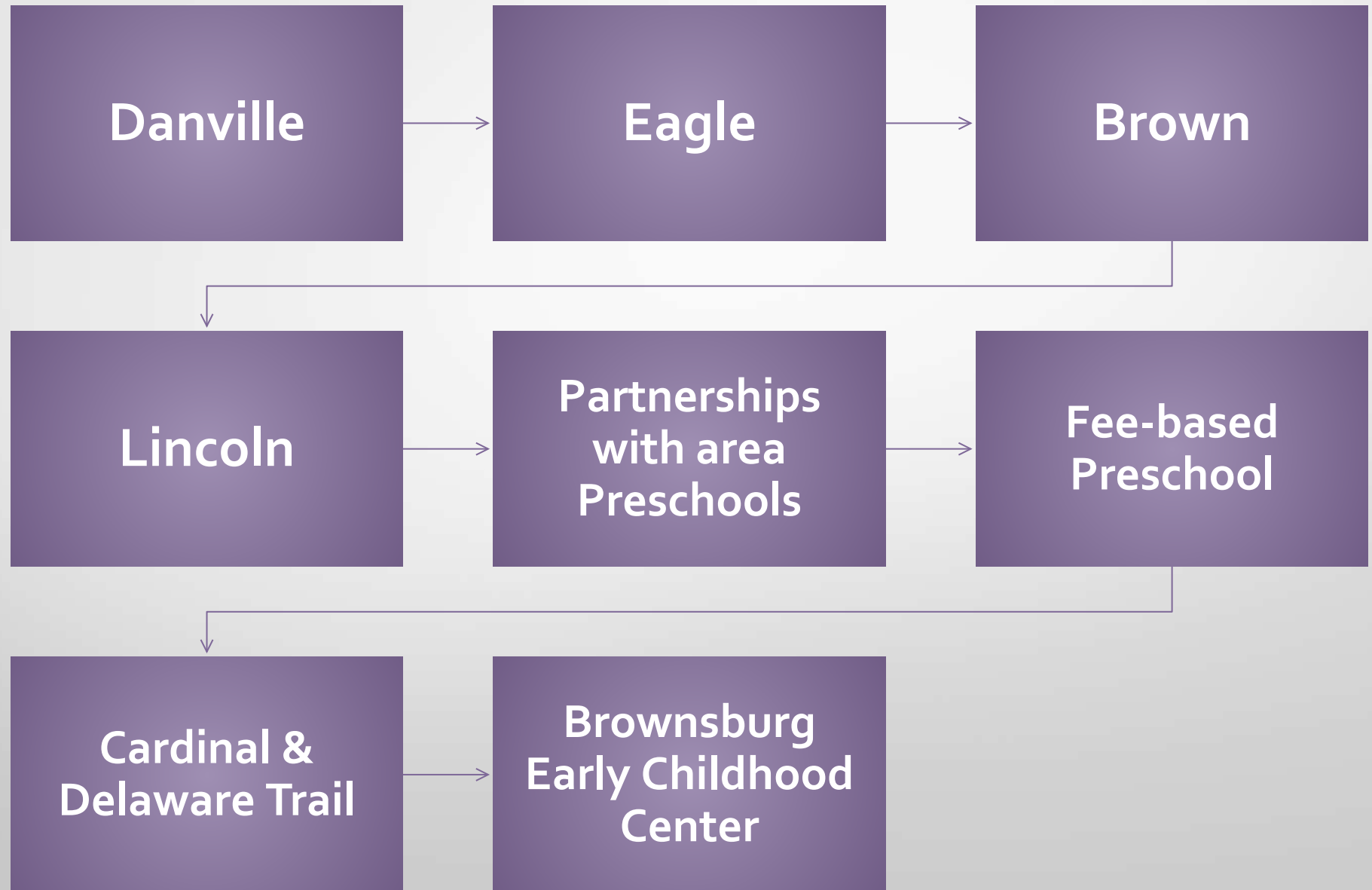

Evaluation Report: Summary of assessments, observations, parent reports, social/developmental history, First Steps reports and/or medical records.



Case Conference: Discuss the evaluation report and student's strengths & needs. Discuss eligibility, goals and programming.

7:00 am – 6:00 pm

- Students participating in child care also receive a half day of preschool

- Special education expertise available to support students in childcare who may struggle in other settings
