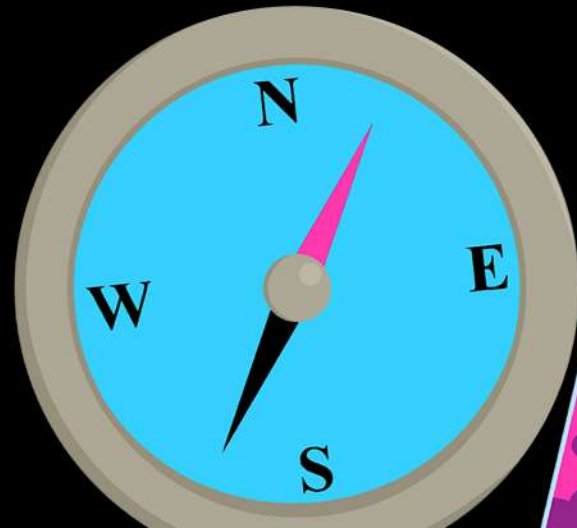
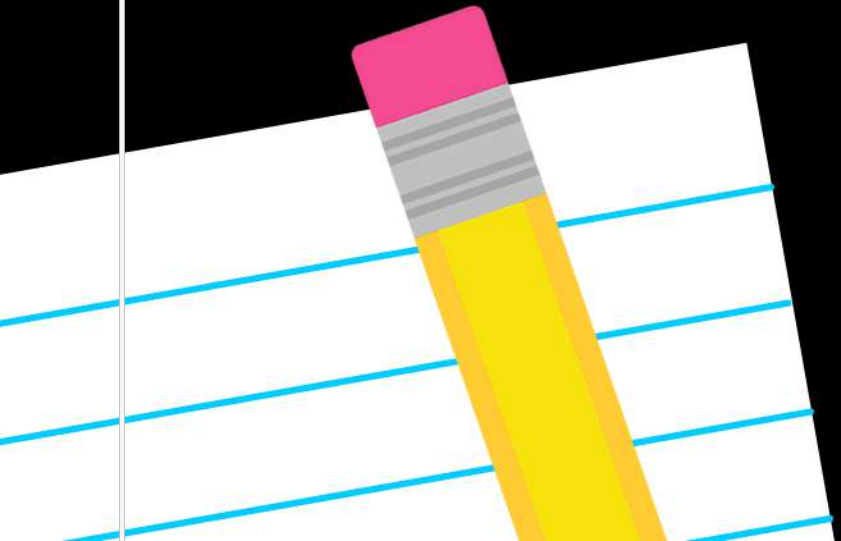

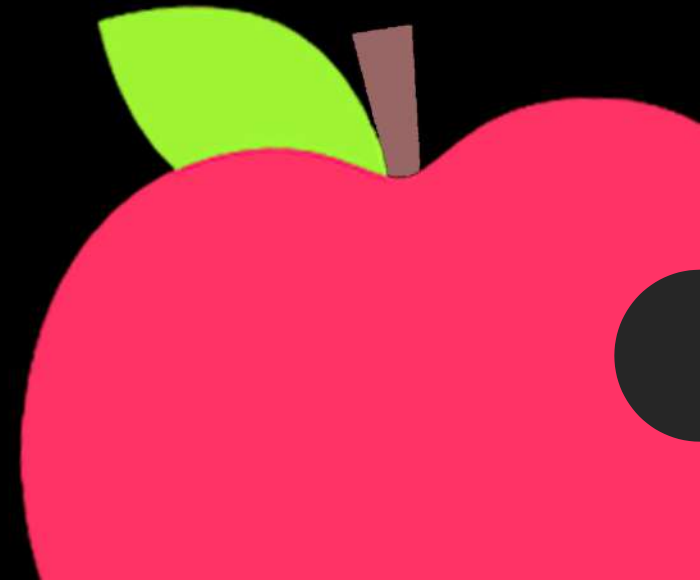
DO I HAVE TO VOLUNTEER?

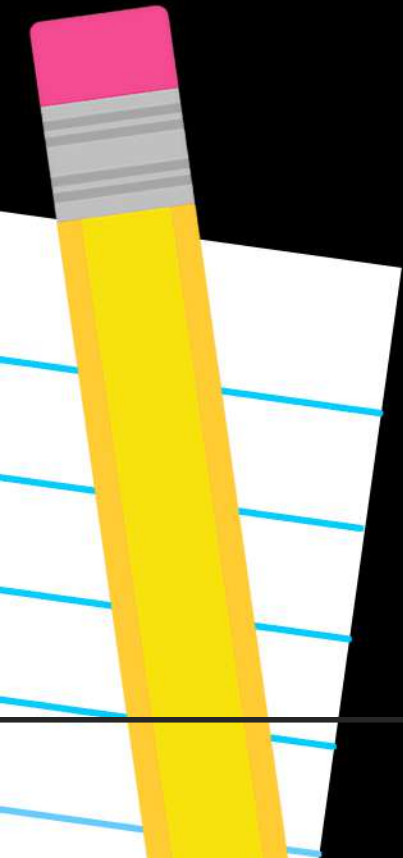

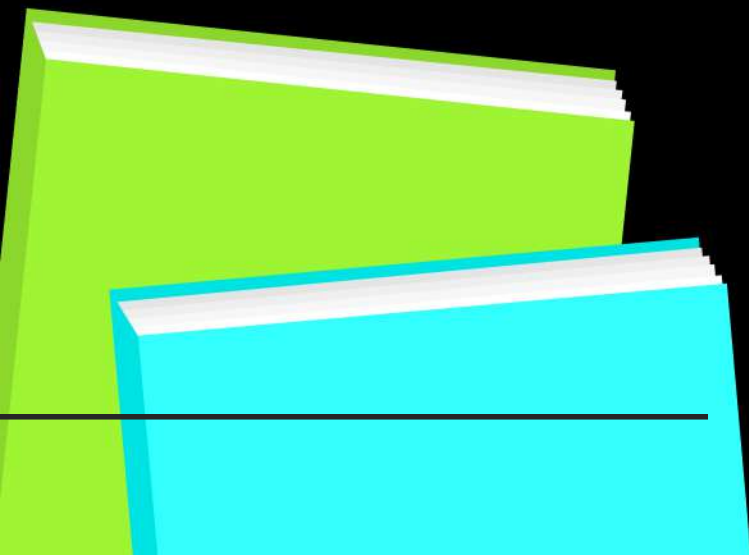

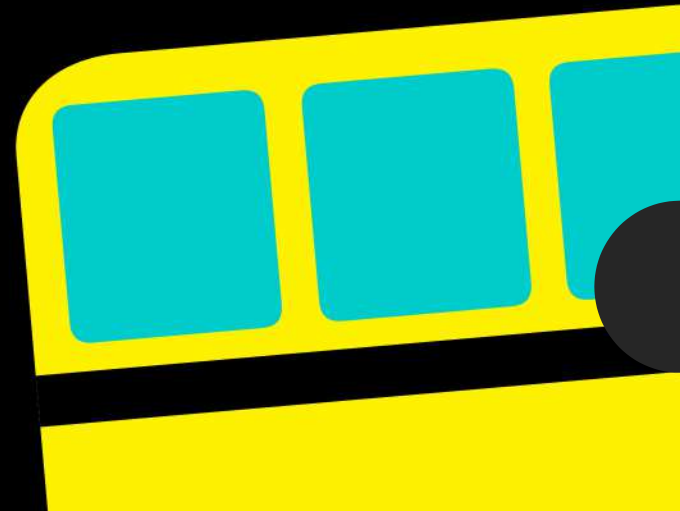
Behavior Chart System

- Secret Reward Puzzle – whole class incentives for fun activities

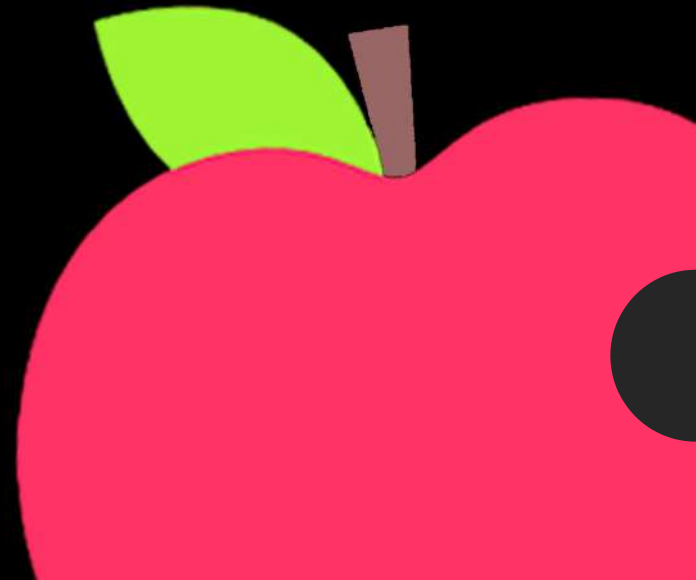


Volunteers

I will then contact parents who are interested in volunteering in the classroom and helping with projects from home.

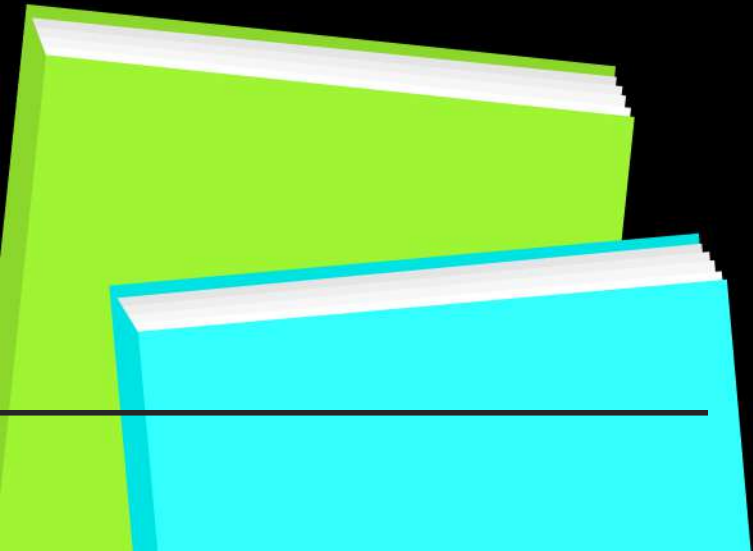


Homework

These are words that are read quickly by sight

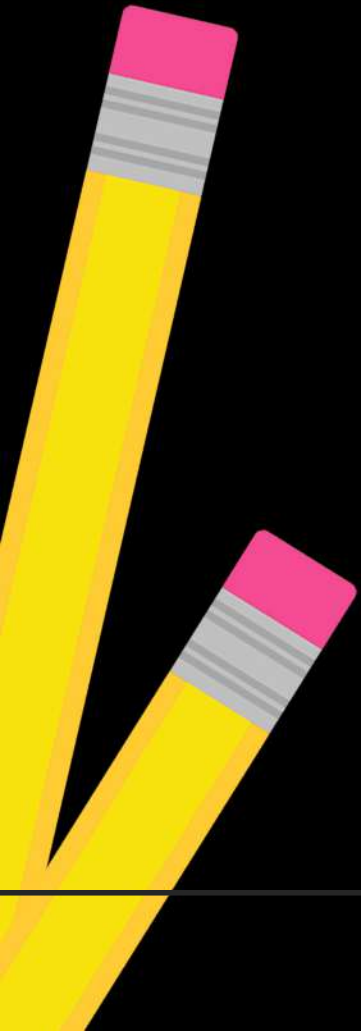
When your child is ready to be tested, please sign the list and return it school in the Ask Me About Folder I test students who return slips on Fridays.

Math

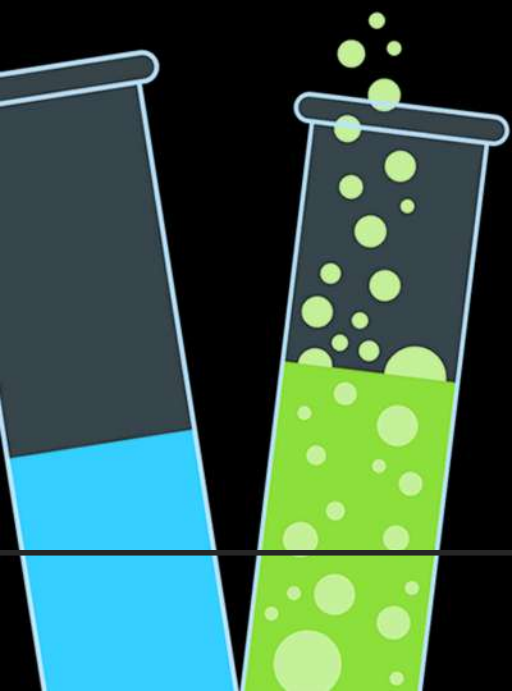
We will use the Envision Common Core Math program. Units of study include addition and subtraction to 20, problem solving, place value, relationship between addition and subtraction, reading, writing and recognizing numbers to 120, time and measurement.



Science

In Science, first graders will be learning about plants, animals, habitats, space, light, and sound.

This will correspond with the Language Arts unit we are studying at the time



Social Studies

First graders will be learning about rules, laws, community helpers, maps, symbols, long ago/today, goods, and services.

This will correspond with the Language Arts unit we are studying at the time



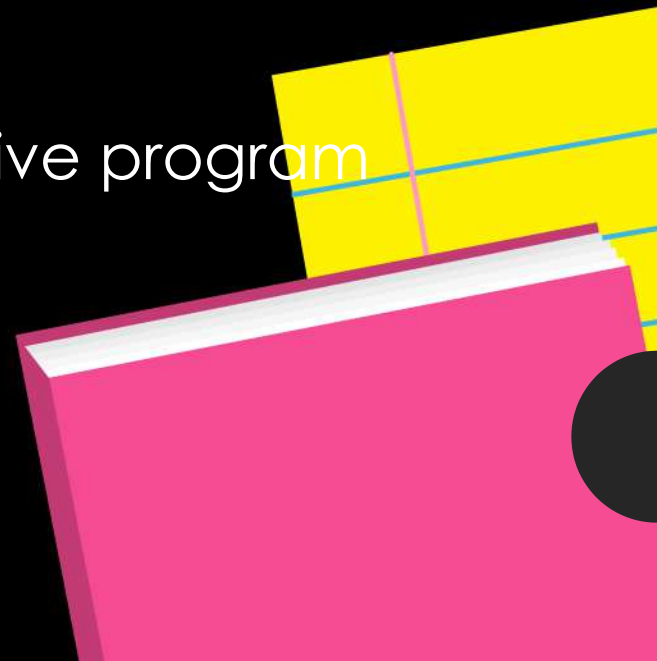
