Criteria

- 3.1.1 EL Status students +/- 4 ELPAC Score
- 3.1.2 ELA GPA +/- 2.0 GPA
- 3.1.3 CAASPP is mandatory +/- 2583 Score
- 3.1.4 TL GPA +/- 3.0 GPA is offered on site
- 3.1.5 AP Language test (if that route) +/- 3 Score
- 3.1.6 Students who do have a passing AP score must submit an On Demand (OD) test, then interview if qualified
- 4 years of a foreign language
 - AP or NS (counts for 2 years) +/- 70% Grade in class
