- 3.1.4 TL GPA +/= 3.0 GPA is offered on site
- 3.1.5 AP Language test (if that route) +/= 3 Score
- 3.1.6 Students who do have a passing AP score must submit an On Demand (OD) test, then interview if qualified
- 4 years of a foreign language
 - \circ AP or NS (counts for 2 years) +/= 70% Grade in class
