

Classroom Policies

- 2020-2021 Brings new challenges so FLEXIBILITY is the key word as we work together to be SUCCESSFUL Learners and develop our BLENDED learning community with both on-site learning and remote learning.
- We need students to complete assignments during the remote learning as well as during the school day.
 - Remote Weeks: Total of 1 ½ hours of "school work"
 - School Weeks: Total of 7 hours on site with core classes, specials, recess and lunch
- Students will be in one location during the two weeks of school for instruction and lunch. Teachers will move between rooms as needed.

5th Grade Reward System

This year, we will use hole punches to track good behavior.

Each student will receive an index card each week.

Teachers will punch the cards when they catch students modeling extraordinary behavior. At the end of each week, homeroom teachers will collect and record of the number of hole punches each child receives. Students may redeem hole punches for the following rewards:

Reward	Number of Punches
5 Extra Points on an Assignment or Quiz	15
Listen to Music During Independent Learning Time	25
Extra Snack from Teacher	30
Free Homework Pass	30
Special Lunch	50

Quarter Rewards

Each quarter, students will have the opportunity to participate in a special class reward event as allowed with adjusted schedules and procedures for 2020-2021. Each student must display exemplary behavior including: being respectful to all students and staff as well as the building, equipment and material at all times. All assignments must be completed. Behavior and classroom performance will be reviewed at the end of each quarter to ensure student eligibility.

Choosing to ignore expectations or engage in inappropriate behavior:

- 1st offense- Warning to Student
- 2rd offense- Reflect ad 1st Strike; Parent signature
- 2 strikes/week- Parent Contact
- 3 Strikes/week- Parent Conference/ Behavior Plan
- 4 Strikes/week- Additional Parent Conference to discuss needed interventions

Blatant disrespect, violence, or any other extreme behavior will result in principal referral and consequences deemed necessary at principal's discretion. Teachers reserve the right to exercise the above steps in any order necessary depending on the severity of the student's misbehavior.

Homework and Missed Assignments:

We will only assign classwork and homework that is beneficial for students to gain important skills and content knowledge to be successful this year and in the future. In case of absences during the week for students on-site, they will be expected to complete makeup work in a timely manner. Students working virtually will be expected to have completed all assigned work by the time they arrive at school for their on-site week. Due to the nature of the 2020-2021 school year, there will be flexibility and understanding of circumstances beyond our control. However, for our students to be as successful as possible, it is important that all assignments are completed to the best of the student's ability.




