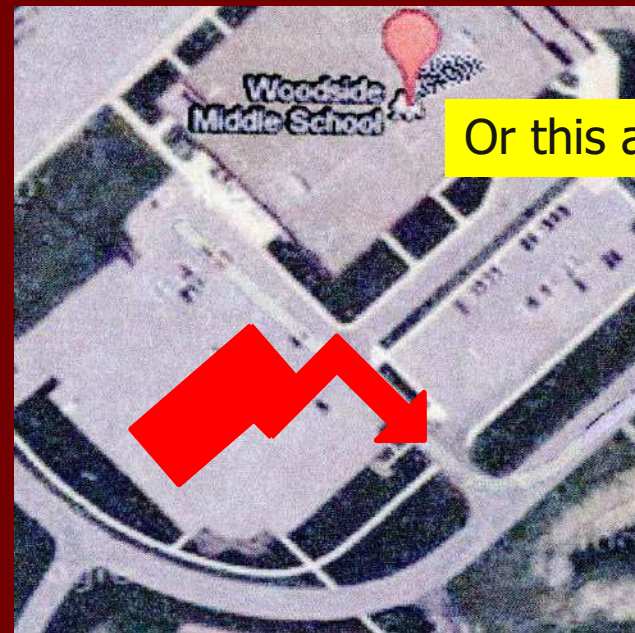
Student Drop Off
