### **High School Enrollment**

- To participate in MCJROTC, you must be enrolled in high school.
- You cannot be attending one high school while participating in MCJROTC in another high school.
- You must be in grades ninth through twelfth to participate.

Cadets must have current school physical evaluations certifying that they are physically fit.


The Semper Fi Fitness program focuses on physical fitness training as well as good nutrition and stress reduction.
