# **ACAP Summative Test**

### April 25-28, 2022

To Parents of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade students at Beulah High School,

All 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders at Beulah High School will take the ACAP Summative test April 25-28, 2022.

The Alabama Comprehensive Assessment Program (ACAP) Summative is a standards-based criterion-referenced assessment designed to provide students, parents, teachers, administrators, and Alabama citizens with information regarding students' progress toward mastery of the Alabama Course of Study Standards.

The ACAP Summative is administered statewide once a year in the spring. The content areas to be assessed are English Language Arts and Math in grades 2 through 8 and Science in grades 4, 6, and 8. To ensure uniform testing conditions, the ACAP Summative is administered using carefully defined directions, materials, and scoring procedures for all test takers.

- 1. School Issued Chromebooks only will be allowed for testing purposes.
- 2. All students must be at BHS no later than 7:40 am. April 25-28, 2022
- 3. These are required tests in Alabama for all 7th and 8th grade students.
- 4. Testing rooms will be posted on the schools Front Door, Lunchroom outside door, and middle school hallway for your name and room location of where you will take the test.
- 5. All 7th and 8th grade students will turn in their chrome books and chargers to their 1st period teachers on <u>Wednesday April 20</u> so we can put them in carts to charge them every night for testing. Chromebooks will be returned to students on Monday after testing. We will put students' names on their chrome book.
