You can do that by going to our website or the district website and signing up by Wednesday the week before you need the meals. There is more information on this on our website. Our counselors will also be available to assist your family and students with finding other community resources or helping your child deal with stress during this time. All of us at Mesa Elementary are committed to supporting all of our students in every way we can.
