- <u>Decomposer</u> an organism that consumes dead or decayed nonliving biomass without need for internal digestion [example: fungi (mushroom, mold)]
- <u>Ecosystem</u> all of the living and nonliving things in an area and the interactions among them (terrestrial ecosystems and aquatic ecosystems)
- 3. <u>Niche</u> the role an organism plays in the ecosystem
- 4. <u>Producer</u> an organism that makes its own food
- 5. <u>Consumer</u> an organism that gets energy from eating another organism
- 6. <u>Herbivore</u> consumers that eat only plants
- 7. <u>Carnivores</u> consumers that eat only animals
- 8. <u>Omnivore</u> consumers that eat both plants and animals
- 9. Food Chain a path of energy transfer from one organism to another
- 10. Food Web an interconnected set of food chains
- 11. <u>Energy Transfer</u> the transfer of energy from one object or material to another or one form to another
- <u>Environment</u> the space and all the living and nonliving things around an organism
- 13. Population all of the interacting members of species in a single area
- 14. Thrive to grow well or strong
