FBI Academy program

The program allows high school students an opportunity to get a comprehensive look into today's FBI.

Generally, each course iteration is a minimum of eight hours nut can be a week-long program with blocks of instruction and demonstrations at a local field office Students are provided with several presentations on the topics including terrorism, cyber-crime, public corruption, polygraph exams, evidence response. SWAT, and the day to day operations of a typical FBI office. Students also learn from special agents, intelligence analysts, language specialists, and professional staff about investigative tactics that include gathering evidence, interviewing witnesses, and assisting with cases.

This will take place in Durango, CO. On Saturday September 17, 2022.










COVID-19 Testing Q&A

- Q: Will Southwest Health System (SHS) provide testing for asymptomatic individuals? (i.e., travelers, preoperative clearance, etc.)
- A: SHS will still provide travel testing; however, a physician's order is required to be covered by insurance. If there is no physician's order or insurance, they will have to pay the cash price. For Pre-Op testing, an order from their provider or surgery center will be processed the same as always.
- Q: Where can a symptomatic individual get a test?

A: For a Rapid (antigen test):

- Over-the-counter (OTC) tests at Walmart, Safeway, City Market, gas stations, etc.
- Walgreens free appointment-based testing: www.walgreens.com/findcare/covid19/testing
- Free test kits directly mailed to you: www.covidtests.gov

For a PCR test:

- The Southwest Medical Group Walk-in Clinic is open Monday through Friday 8 am to 7 pm, Saturday and Sunday 9 am to 5 pm.
- Walgreens has appointment-based testing that is free.
- With a provider's order, testing is available at the Park Street Draw Station.
