In order to become a Scholar, you must provide documentation that shows you have completed the process successfully.)

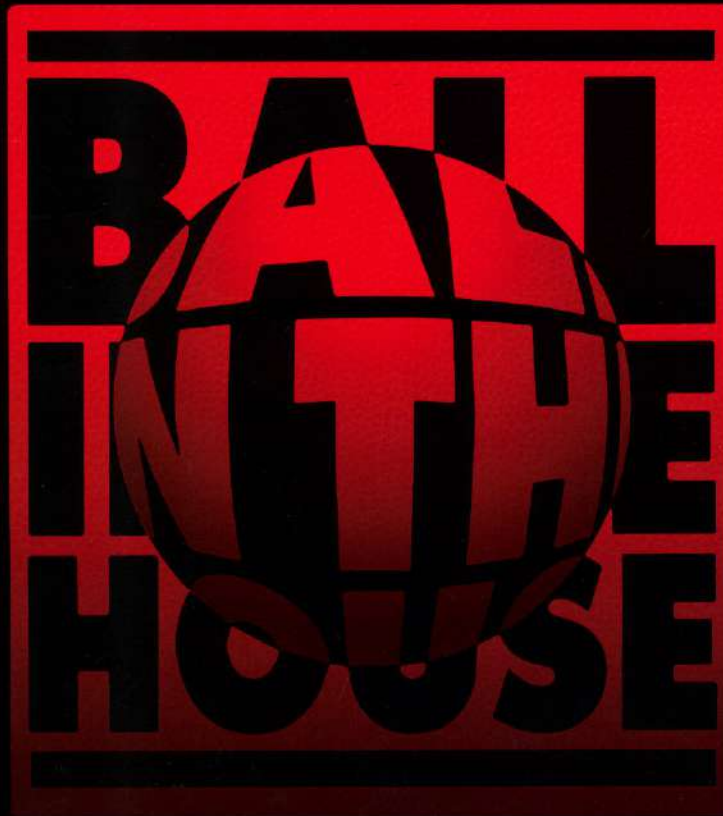

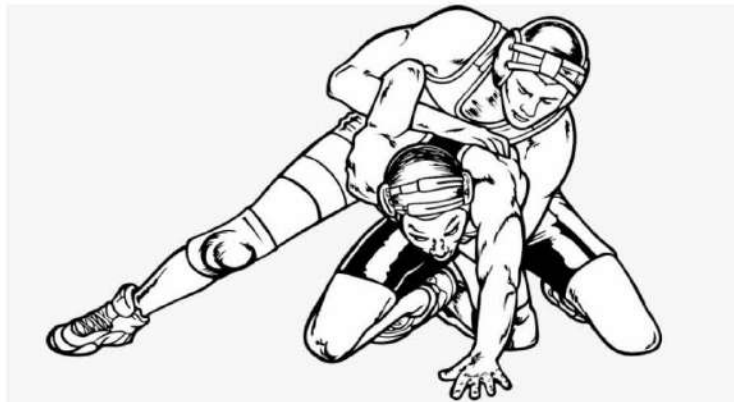
