# Curriculum Corner

We have begun preparation for the AZMerit tests. Fourth grade students will test in Reading, Writing, Math, and Science. We are discussing test taking strategies as well as reviewing all of the concepts we have discussed throughout this year. The reading test will include; vocabulary, making predictions, forming inferences, and comprehension. For writing, students will be given passages to read and then asked to respond in writing using supporting evidence from the texts. Some of the math concepts will focus on fractions, geometry, multiplication and division, and solving multiple step problems. The science test will cover plant and animal adaptations and classification, electricity, magnetism, Earth's processes, water and weather, and using the scientific method.

To make sure we are completely prepared for AZMerit tests, we want to make sure our 4th graders are at their best. Here are a few suggestions for the students:

<u>Eat and Sleep</u> - Eat a healthy and nutritious breakfast and get a good night's rest to properly fuel your mind.
