We've been learning to recognize and handle our feelings and we'll continue this unit until spring break. We have a fun song we sing along with a puppet friend, Felicia Feelings, that goes to the familiar tune "If You're Happy and You Know It."

Among the strategies are: If you're sad and you know it tell a friend, "I'm Sad." (Talk to someone about your sadness) and then figure out what to do together.) If you're angry and you know it take a breath. (Use calm-down strategies). If you're embarrassed and you know it laugh it off. (Say "Silly me!" and learn to laugh at your mistakes. If you're scared and you know it tell and adult "I'm scared." (Feeling fearful is an adult problem. They will keep you safe.)

Feelings change when you change what you do, and you can get your sunshine BACK!

March PE & Music

In kindergarten PE we will start our jumping unit where we practice jumps while pretending to be olympic athletes. You can ask your child their favorite activity in PE so far. In preschool PE we finished our Fluffball Fun unit where we explored catching, tossing, and throwing with fluffballs. Next we will begin our Fancy Feet unit practicing some basic soccer dribbling and kicking.

In kindergarten music we are reading books with a common theme and comparing and contrasting them. We have been practicing different rhythms as well as working on our steady beat. You can ask your child what their favorite song to sing in music is. In preschool music we will read some favorite children's books and learn new songs and dances.

Reading aloud together creates shared experiences that remind us of good times and good lessons. A simple phrase in a book can catch on and remind us of the right thing years later, as in Dr. Seuss' *Horton Hatches the Egg*: "I meant what I said and I said what I meant. An elephant is faithful, one hundred percent."
