WATERBURY GOOGLE LOGIN INFO:

Username: Your username is your first and last initial, then your student ID followed by @student.waterbury.k12.ct.us

Password: Your password is the 1st three numbers of your student ID, then your first initial (CAPITALIZED), then your last name initial (lowercase), then the last 3 numbers of your student ID. Please contact your child's teacher if the password is not working, and you may be given a new password that will not follow this pattern.

Example

Child's Name: Amy Brown	Student ID: 123456

20 mins (or more)	Daily Skills Review *** Most important ***	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. https://login.i-ready.com/ Try to get in 100 minutes a week!! If you are unable to access the site, or once your child's 100 minutes are up, they can switch to Prodigy. :) 2. https://play.prodigygame.com/ Use the student google login described above to sign in!!
20 mins (or more)	Daily Grade Level Math Lessons	<p>http://khanacademy.org Students login with their waterbury gmail accounts. Click "sign in with google". Your child's login is the first initial and last initial followed by their student ID number. After this you type "@student.waterbury.k12.ct.us" Their password is the first 3 numbers of their student ID followed by their first initial capitalized and the first letter of their last name capitalized.</p> <p>Example: Amy Brown Login: AB123456@student.waterbury.k12.ct.us Password: 123Ab456</p> <p>Many of them know how to do this! I will assign grade level lessons here according to our school's curriculum. Ask if you have any issues :)</p>
10 mins	Math Talk with a Grown Up/ Daily Math from Ms. Marques	<p>Write down any fact (2 or 3 digit addition/subtraction). Have your child solve in his/her head using a number line, related facts, decomposing numbers, or any strategy he/she likes. Ask your child to explain his/her thinking and then you can share how you would have done it.</p> <p>Check Google Classroom for Daily Life Math Problem!</p>

10 mins	Vocabulary	<p>Check here for the word of the day: https://www.superkids.com/aweb/tools/words/middle/</p> <p>On a piece of paper that you can hang on the wall, write down the word, definition, and one sentence. Illustrate if you'd like! Review all the words you've learned each day.</p>
5 mins	Fluency *** Most important ***	<p>I will post a weekly fluency passage on Google Classroom & Class Tag! Do this like you do your normal homework routine.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Set a timer for 1 minute and have your child read aloud. 2. Track how many words they read. 3. Finish reading the passage. 4. Answer a question. 5. Repeat daily! :)
20 mins (OR MORE!!)	READ INDEPENDENTLY!! *** Most important ***	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Use the books on Wonders (READ yourself, don't just let them read to you!!) <p>Access Wonders through http://waterbury.k12.ct.us/17/home</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Use any books at home or follow daily resources from: https://classroommagazines.scholastic.com/support/learnathome/grades-3-5.html</p>
15 mins	Respond to Reading	<p>In a notebook or typed, choose one question to answer:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Why do you think the author wrote this book? 2. Share with me your favorite part of the book so far? Why is this your favorite part? 3. What is the main idea of the text? 4. Summarize what you just read. 5. Choose one character in the story to describe. Remember to use important details. 6. What did you learn from reading this book? 7. Describe the setting of the story. 8. Describe an important event in the story. 9. Is the narrator a character in the story? 10. What is the theme of the book? 11. Would you recommend this book to a friend? Tell why or why not.
