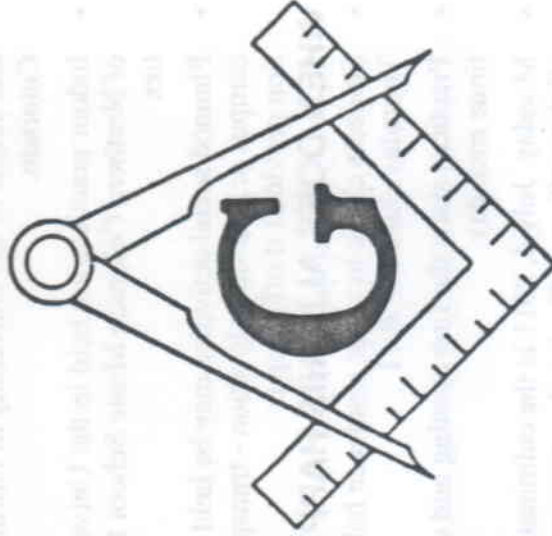
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

WHAT IS THE COLORADO MASONIC HIGH SCHOOL BAND CAMP?

- A five-day band clinic hosted by the Grand Lodge of Colorado
- The band plays at the Greeley Stampede Bar-B-Q, holds a free public patriotic concert at the University Center, and marches in the Greeley Independence Day Stampede Parade
- Scholarships for the band clinic are available from many Masonic Organizations such as Masonic Lodges, Eastern Star Chapters, Scottish Rite, York Rite or Shrine Clubs

WHAT IS THE COLORADO MASONIC HIGH SCHOOL BAND CAMP?

- All talented Colorado High School band students in their freshman (9th grade) through junior year (11th grade) with experience in at least one marching band instrument

HOW DO MY STUDENTS BECOME PART OF THIS BAND CAMP?

- Notices and registrations forms will be mailed to from High School Band Directors in early March.
- Student must be recommended or approved by their High School Band Director
- Contact a Masonic Organization near you or call the Grand Lodge Office at 719-417-9587.

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE COLORADO MASONIC HIGH SCHOOL BAND CAMP?

- Students practice two to three times a day under the direction of Dr. R. Mayne, Dr. K. Droce and their staff from the University of Northern Colorado and
- Planned evening social activities include a dance, pizza party, and talent show.
- This is an opportunity to meet new friends and renew old acquaintances across the state.

WHERE DOES ALL THIS HAPPEN?

- Student rooms and meals will be on the campus of the University of Northern Colorado - adult supervision at all times.
- Marching practices are held on the field and streets of the University of Northern Colorado.
- Indoor practices are held in the University of Northern Colorado Music School facilities
- Planned social activities may be held on campus or at another location - transportation provided if off campus

WHEN DOES ALL THIS HAPPEN?

- Students check in to the residence hall on Thursday, June 30, 2011
- Practices start the first evening and continue each day
- Monday July 4, 2011 is the culmination of all their efforts - The band participate in the Greeley Rocky Mountain Stampede Parade - there are about 50,000 spectators.

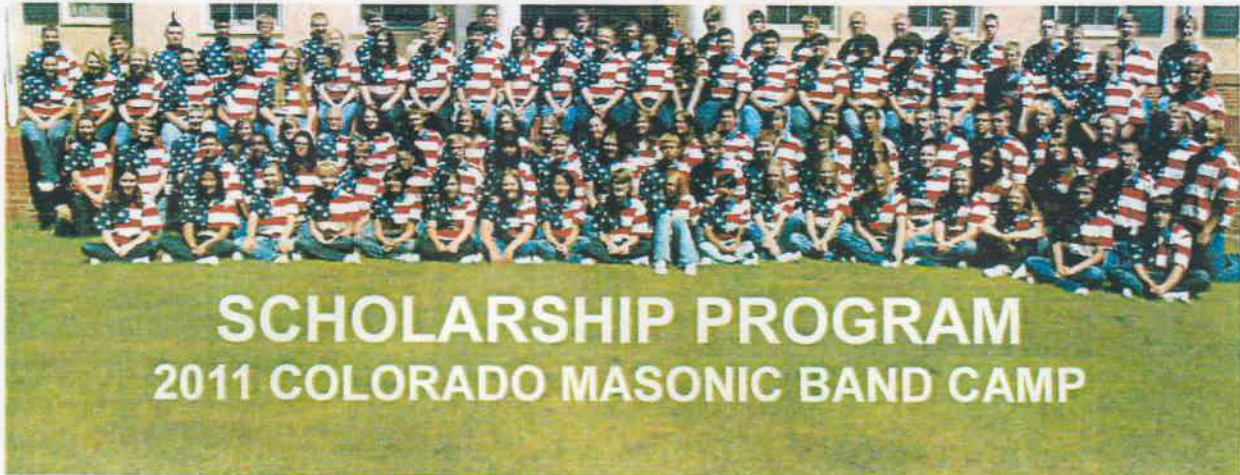
