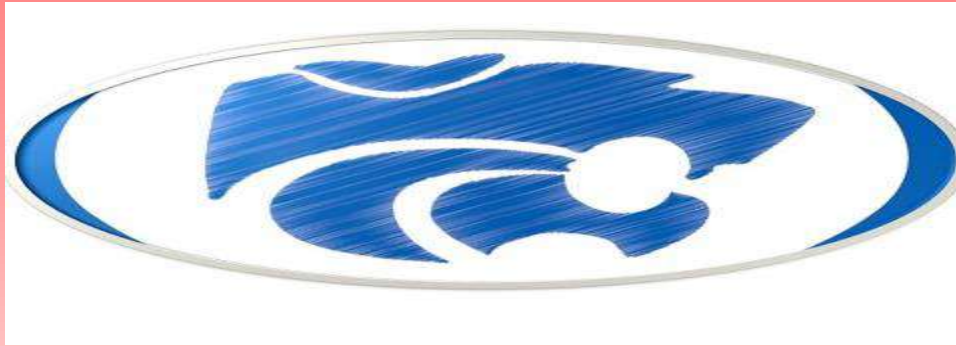

## F 8/9 CLOSED CAMPUS POLICY

If you give permission for your student to leave school with someone who is not the parent/legal guardian or on the Emergency contact, you are asked to **provide written, signed notification stating the time the student is to be picked up and the name of the person with whom he/she is leaving campus.** That person is required to come to the office to sign the checkout book when the student leaves **and** when he/she returns. ### Dear Parents/Guardian:

Also~ **NEW ANNUAL IMMUNIZATION EXEMPTION REQUIREMENT**– Please be aware that Colorado has changed the law regarding immunization exemptions. Beginning July 1, 2018, non-medical (personal and religious) immunization exemption forms will be required to be filled out every school year. If your student currently has an exemption on file with the school district, it will expire June 30th, 2019, and a new one will need to be filled out after July 1st, 2019.

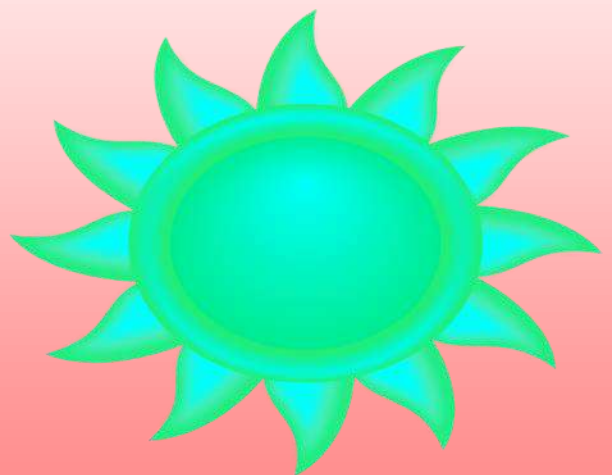
