#### Covid-19 UPDATES!

#### **Mountain Brook High School Bands**

The MBHS Marching Spartan Band provides the opportunity to understand and enjoy music through instructional activities that lead to the performance of music for outdoor events. It enforces the basic musical elements common to all sound instrumental music instructional programs and is one component of a well-balanced secondary level instrumental music program. Although the main reason for its existence is to promote musical growth and understanding, the marching band also serves a valuable role in meeting the needs of the school and community through extracurricular activities that strengthen public relations, provide entertainment for outdoor functions, and encourage parental involvement in school activities.

The MBHS Marching Band is composed of 9th-12th grade students who are currently a member of the MBJHS Band Program and the MBHS Band Program. The band combines members of the Dorians and the Color Guard to create the Marching Spartans. Although composed of several groups, the MBHS Marching Band is one unit with the singular goal of creating exciting performances for our audience.

The MBHS Marching Spartan Band will perform at all varsity football games, select pep rallies, parades and select band competitions. Competitions in the marching band setting can be an effective motivational experience for students if used as a means for teaching and reinforcing positive behaviors in the context of a well-balanced secondary level instrumental music program. Marching band competitions should be approached as one of the many learning opportunities available to students in the marching band, but not the primary reason for the marching band's existence.

#### **Band Camp Information**

Band camp is required of all band members. All band students are expected to be ready for camp by preparing physically and mentally over the summer break. Students who practice their instrument, prepare their music, and spend time outside in order to become acclimated to the heat will fare better during band camp.

Band Camp typically begins 2-3 weeks before school begins. As **all students are expected at band camp**, please make arrangements to avoid conflicts with vacations, summer camps, and other important happenings. Missed rehearsals by any student has a huge impact on other students. Please communicate conflicts early and often.

#### Regular Rehearsal Schedule

The Marching Spartans rehearse regularly after school each day. For the most accurate schedule, please use the google calendar on the band website. Dates are subject to change, so please check the website calendar often.

\*Football Playoff Games are required. Rehearsals for playoff games will take place on the day before the game from 3:45-4:30.

#### **Attendance Policy**

Attendance at all rehearsals and performances is mandatory unless prior arrangements have been negotiated. Exceptions may be made based on specific circumstances. If a band member misses a rehearsal they are expected to make up any material that was covered in that rehearsal. Notification of an absence (other than an illness) must be submitted to Mr. Smith in writing at least 2 weeks prior to the rehearsal or performance.

The following reasons are excusable absences from band rehearsals or performances: weddings, funerals, religious observances, close family graduations, illnesses, or conflicts with a school activity that have been documented in advance and approved by Mr. Smith.

The following reasons are not excusable absences from band rehearsals or performances: part time jobs, birthdays or birthday parties, non-school related sporting events, concerts or other entertainment events, packing or cleaning for vacations, homework, studying for tests, being tired, or having a busy week.

If you think you have a conflict with a scheduled rehearsal or performance please contact Mr. Smith as early as possible so that the matter can be resolved in the best interests of the band member and the ensemble.

#### Band Fees

\$200 Band Fee, WINDS AND PERCUSSION
 \$125 Band Fee, DORIANS

This fee is due from each student by July 16, 2021. This fee will help defer cost of instruction, show design, drill writing, music arranging, and other costs associated with camp.

• \$125 Uniform Fee (WINDS AND PERCUSSION)

This fee is due from each wind and percussion student by July 16, 2021. This fee covers the cost associated with uniform care for the season.

**Marching Band uniforms** are provided by the band program. Uniforms consist of bib pants, a band jacket, and a shako (hat). Each person in the band will be individually sized for a uniform during band camp each year. Students may need to alter the length of the bib pants in order for them to fit properly. Uniforms must be properly checked out before each performance and returned immediately after the performance. Students must take care of uniforms by hanging them up properly. Aside from special circumstances, students are not allowed to have food or drink in uniform. No jewelry should be worn with marching band uniform.

Students must provide the following items for their marching band uniform:

- Black athletic socks, LONG no short socks or no-see-ums are allowed.
- **DSI Vector** (black marching band shoes) available for purchase via band website.
- Black athletic shorts
- **Director specified t-shirt** (band shirt provided)

**Symphonic Band uniforms** consist of a tuxedo for boys and a black concert dress for girls. The band program has tuxedos for males to use. Students must provide a white tuxedo shirt and black dress shoes. Female students may wear a concert dress provided by the band program or purchase one of their own. In addition, female students must provide black flat dress shoes to complete their uniform. No jewelry should be worn with a symphonic band uniform.

#### MBS Band Parent Association

The MBHS Band Parent Association is composed of parents of band students from every level of the MBS Band Program, grades 6-12. We encourage all parents to support their students' musical aspirations as well as physically support the fundraising goals of our entire program.
