#### d. Superintendent Communication

Superintendent Patrick Kelley expressed his appreciation to the Human Resources staff for putting on a lovely retirement event for 144 staff members retiring this year. He announced that a mock mass casualty drill will be held after school on Monday, May 18 at Shivela Middle School. The drill will simulate an active-shooter incident and will allow school and district personnel, police and emergency responders to work together to train for an active shooter incident utilizing the Rescue Task Force (RTF) response to provide rapid medical treatment at the point of injury to those who have been injured. Mr. Kelley announced that Murrieta Mesa High School has been selected to receive a Models of Excellence award for their Medical Pathways Partnership.

#### e. Board Communications

Trustee Paul Diffley remarked that our graduation rates are phenomenal and expressed his appreciation to teachers for all they do to prepare students. He stated that there will be an entire library of skill sets leaving the district with the high number of staff retiring this year. He is looking forward to the mock casualty drill and thanked the local fire and police departments.

Trustee Robin Crist announced that this year the Dollars for Scholars Scholarship Foundation presented \$190,000 in scholarships to 222 students. She expressed her appreciation to the foundation's many volunteers and donors. She congratulated Teachers of the Year, Markela Parson and Christina Thomas-Kelley, and thanked the student representatives for their leadership skills and great monthly school reports.

Trustee Barbara Muir thanked the Human Resources department for the wonderful retirement event. She commended the student representatives and wished them luck in their future endeavors.

Trustee Kris Thomasian thanked student representatives for sharing exciting school events. She read aloud a few of the many positive comments posted via Facebook by Murrieta parents in response to an out-of-state parent with a special needs child requesting assistance to determine the best school placement in Murrieta.
