CHARLESTON BOARD OF EDUCATION REGULAR MEETING September 24, 2018

The Charleston Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, September 24, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Fine Arts Building. Mr. Trey Gage established a quorum and called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m..
