The annual Chino Holiday parade will take place on Saturday, December 13th, 2013.

The students from Magnolia JHS will be required to meet at MAGNOLIA JHS **at 7:00 a.m.** This will give us enough time to set up, warm-up, dress in uniform, and tune before the bus is scheduled to arrive. Once the students arrive at the school, BAND students are to report to the Band Room (Room 33), GUARD students to the GUARD ROOM.

BAND Students are to wear blue band shirts, black spandex shorts, black band shoes, and black mid-calf or crew socks. GUARD students have already been assigned their dress requirements. Please do not allow the students to wear rings, wristbands, earrings, makeup, or hairspray/gel. Any long hair is to be up off of the shoulders and pinned up on **TOP** of the head. **NO PONY TAILS OR BUNS ON THE BACK OF THE HEAD PLEASE.**

The bus will take the band to Ramona JHS, where we will stage and prepare for the parade. The parade is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m., and will run along Riverside Drive from Yorba to Central and then south on Central to Chino. Upon completion of the parade, we will get back on the bus and return to Magnolia JHS to put away the uniforms and equipment. The students should be done by 12-12:30 pm.

If anyone will be recording our performance on video, it would be greatly appreciated if a copy could be sent in for our archive. The best videos show the entire group as much as possible while we are marching and playing. Thank you in advance for your assistance.
