PLEDGE Contribution Information

The Magnolia Junior High Music Boosters is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization formed by parents of students in the Band and Color Guard Program. Parent organization like the Booster clubs connect students, parents and community members with our rich music program at Magnolia Jr. High. The organization strives to raise funds to benefit and support the educational experiences of our Magnolia students in this Music Program. The primary role of a parent organization or booster club is to enrich students' participation in music education. A pledge contribution is a voluntary monetary contribution that has been set to cover expenses related to the different components of our Music Program not completely funded by the School District.
