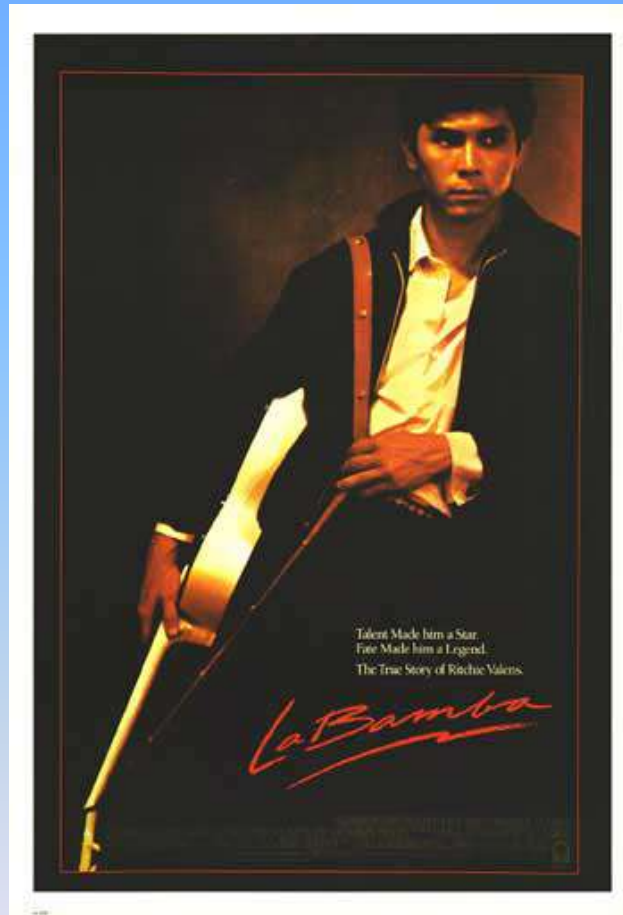


# Based on a True Story 500

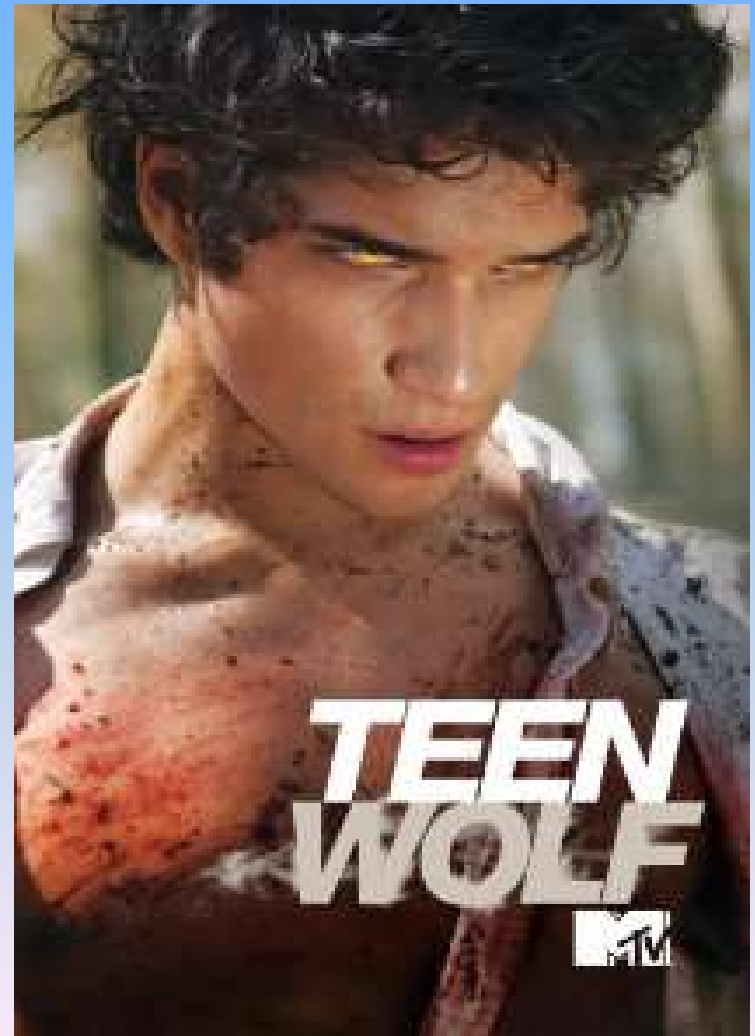


# Movies to TV 100

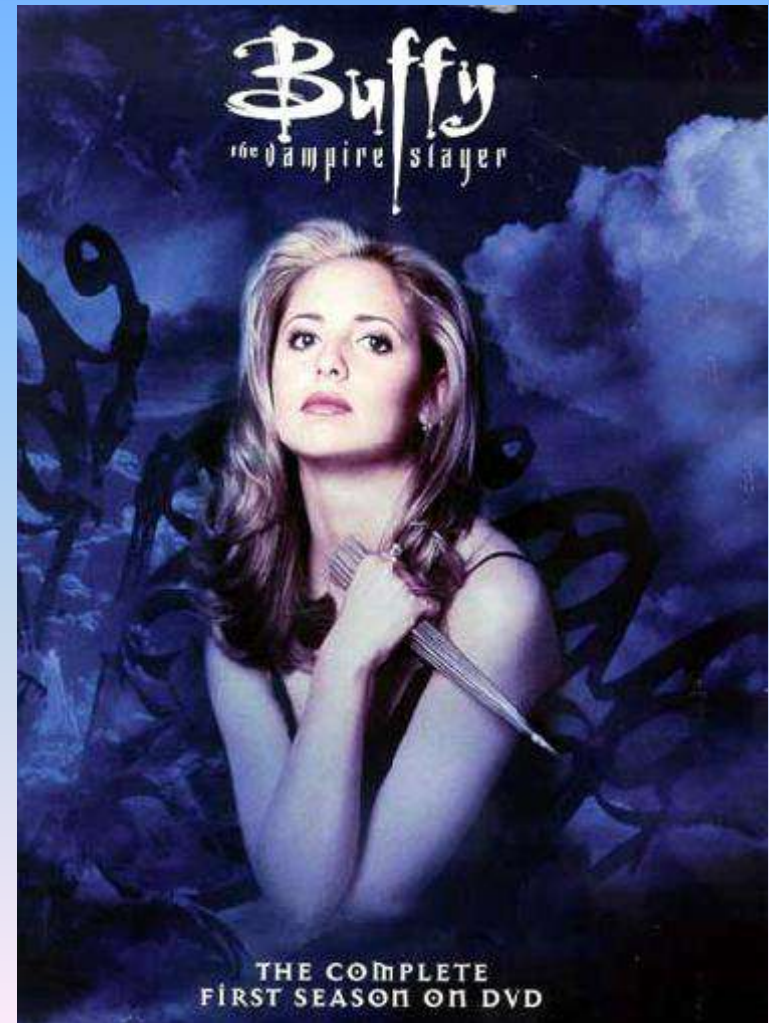
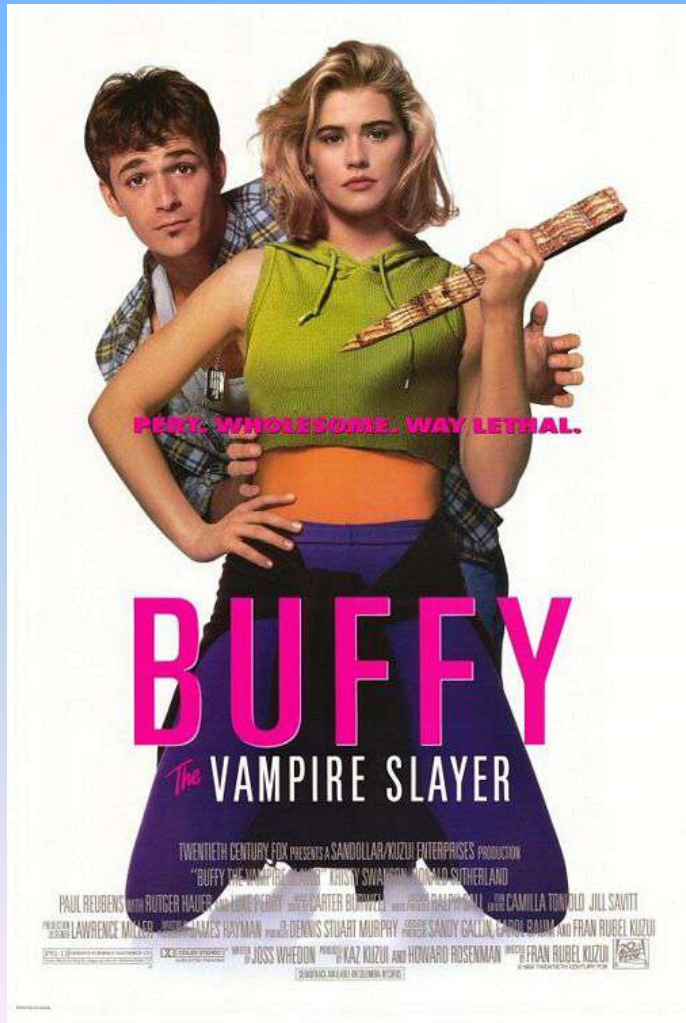


## Movies to TV 300

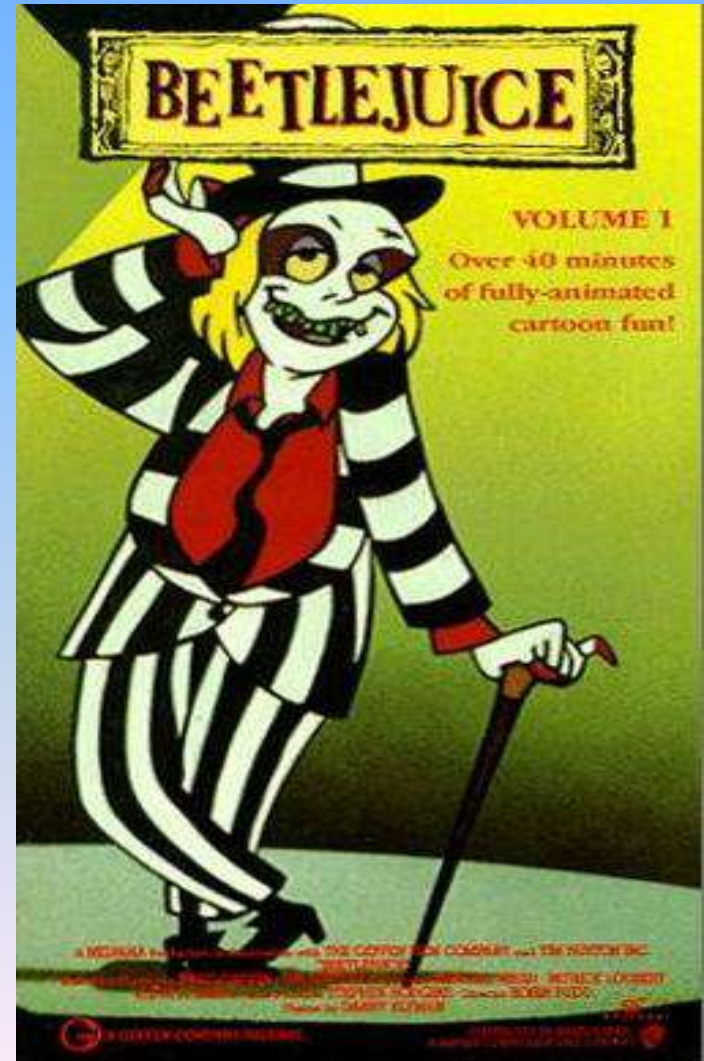
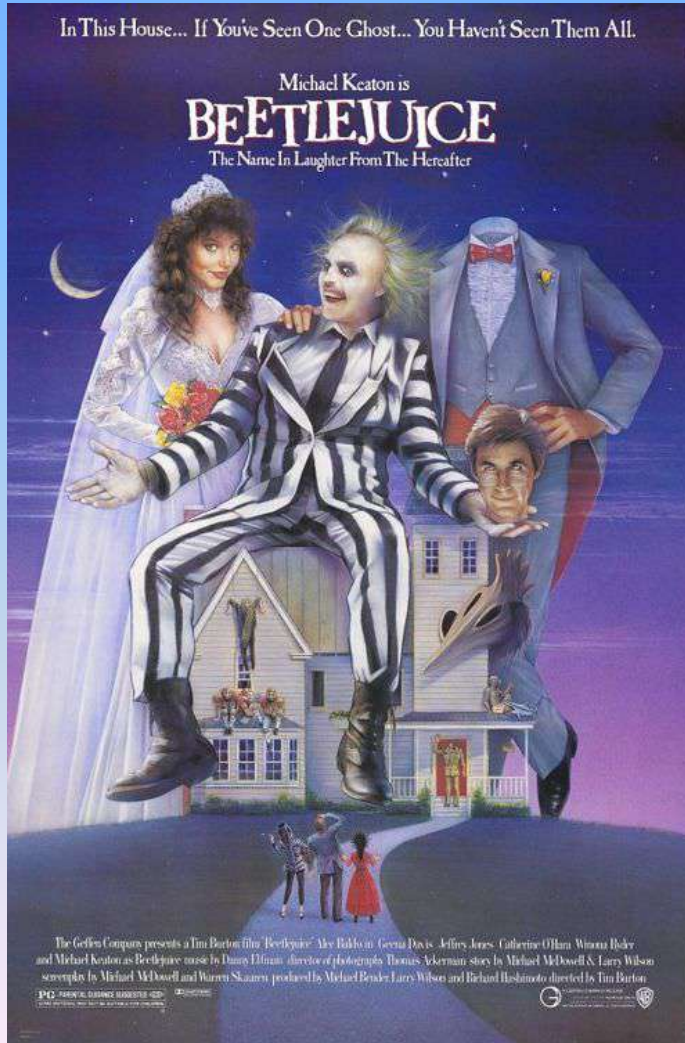


# Movies to TV 400

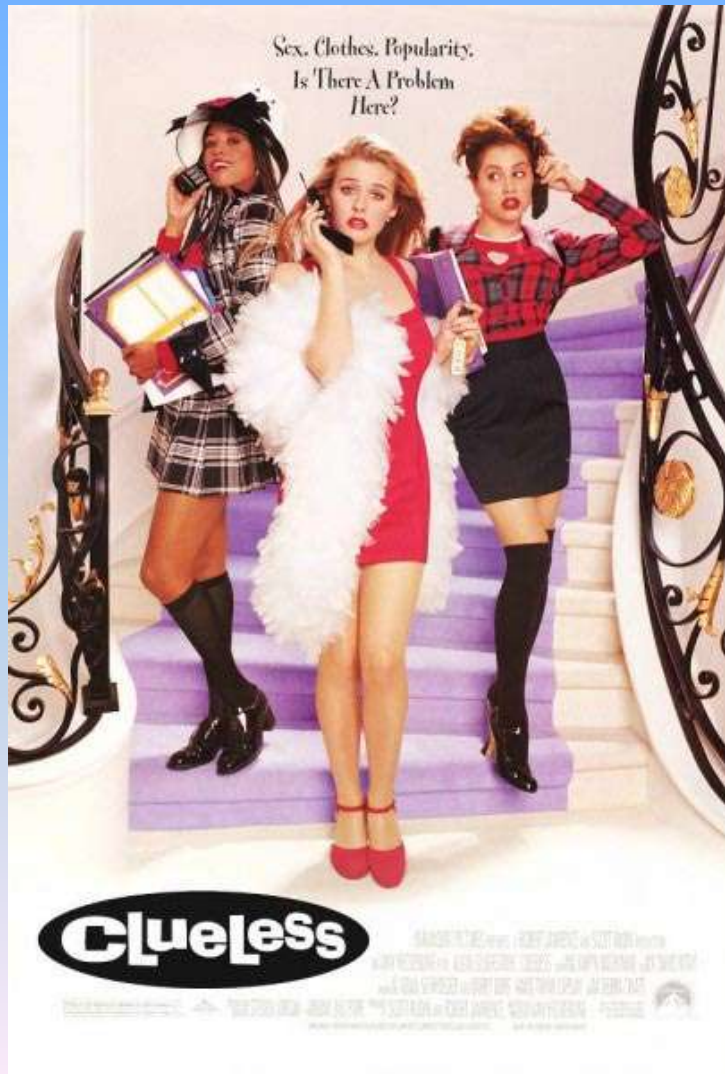


# Movies to TV 500

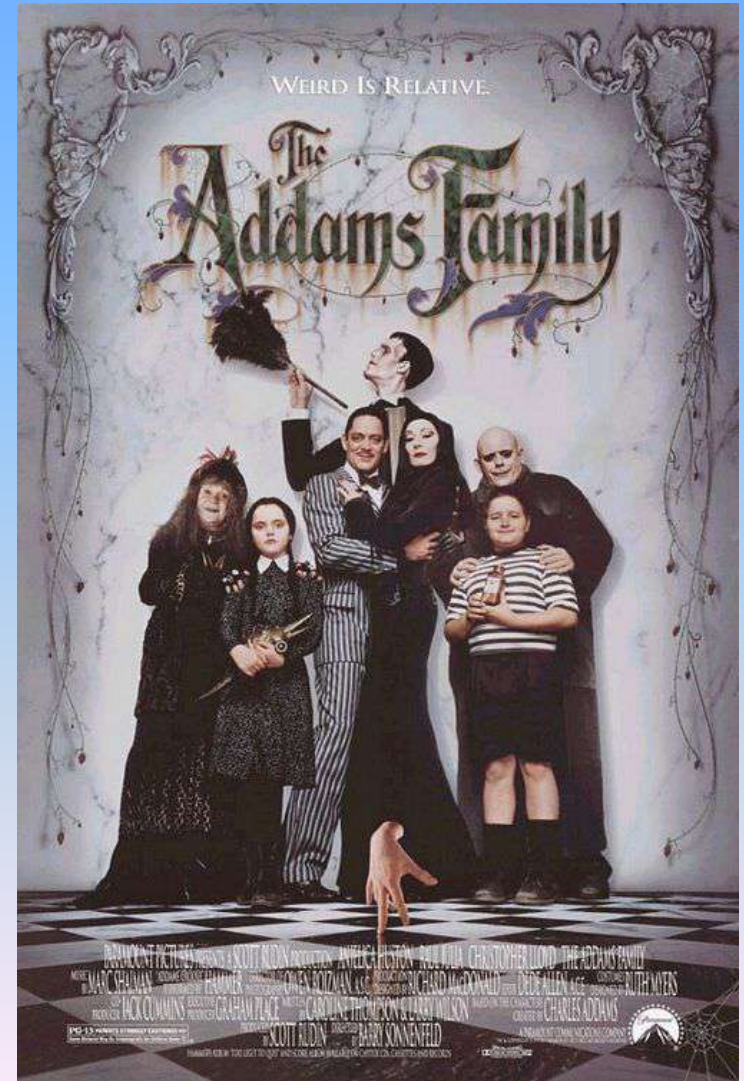
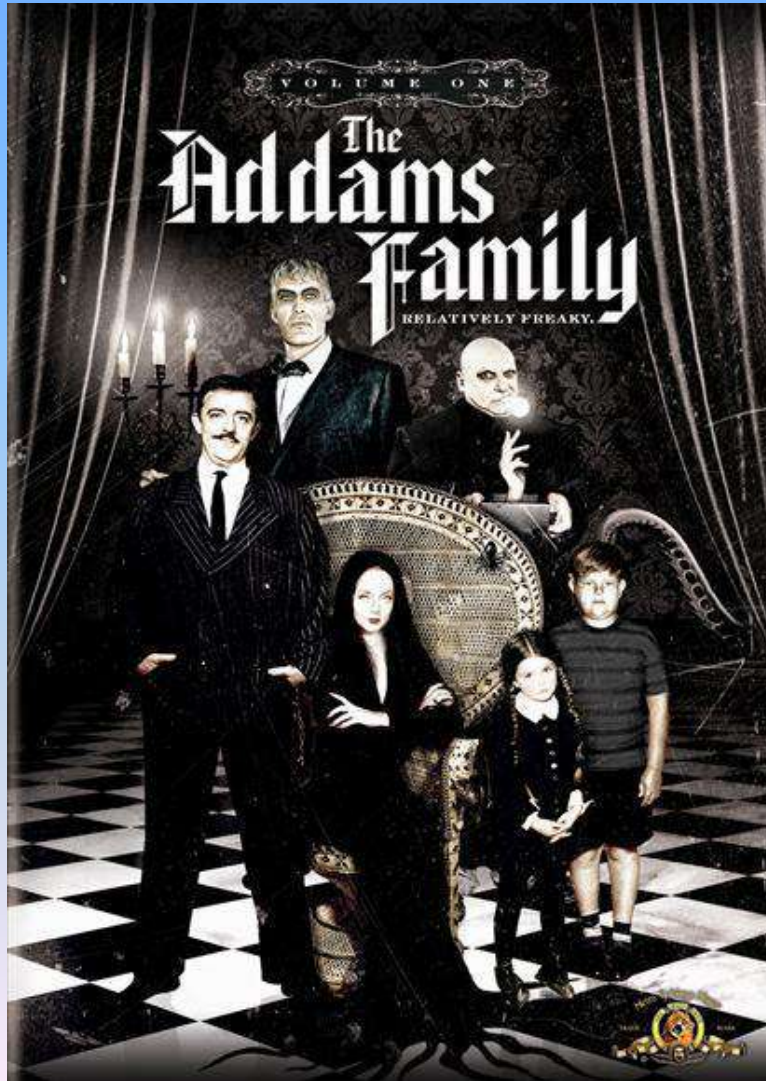
# TV to Movies 100

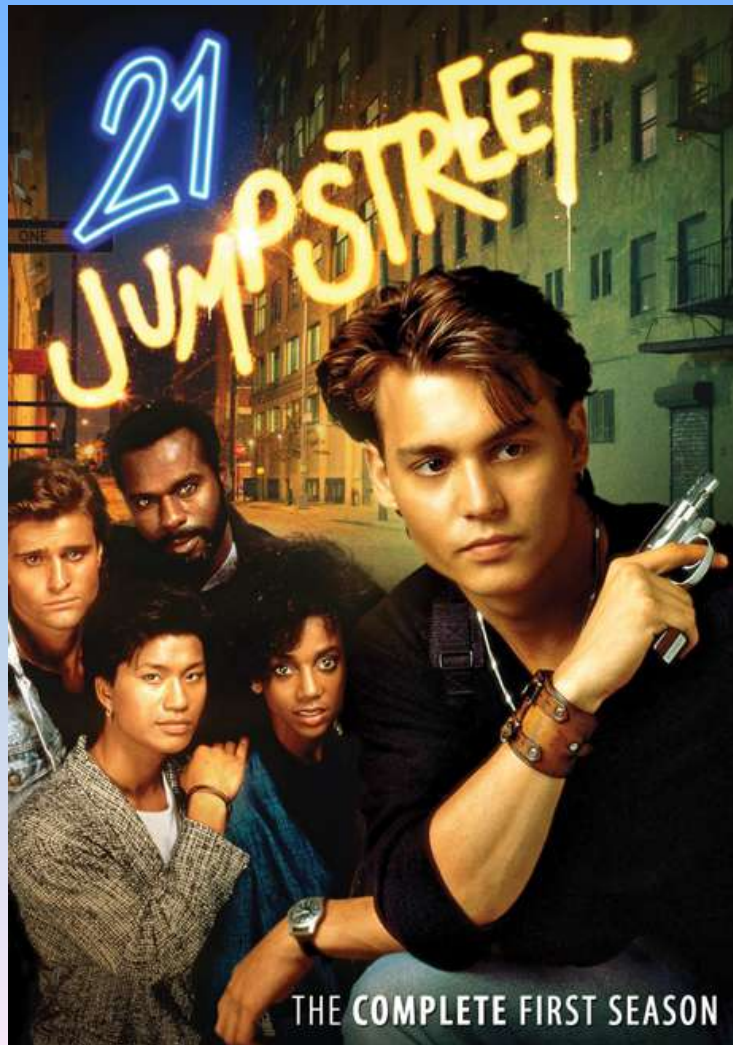

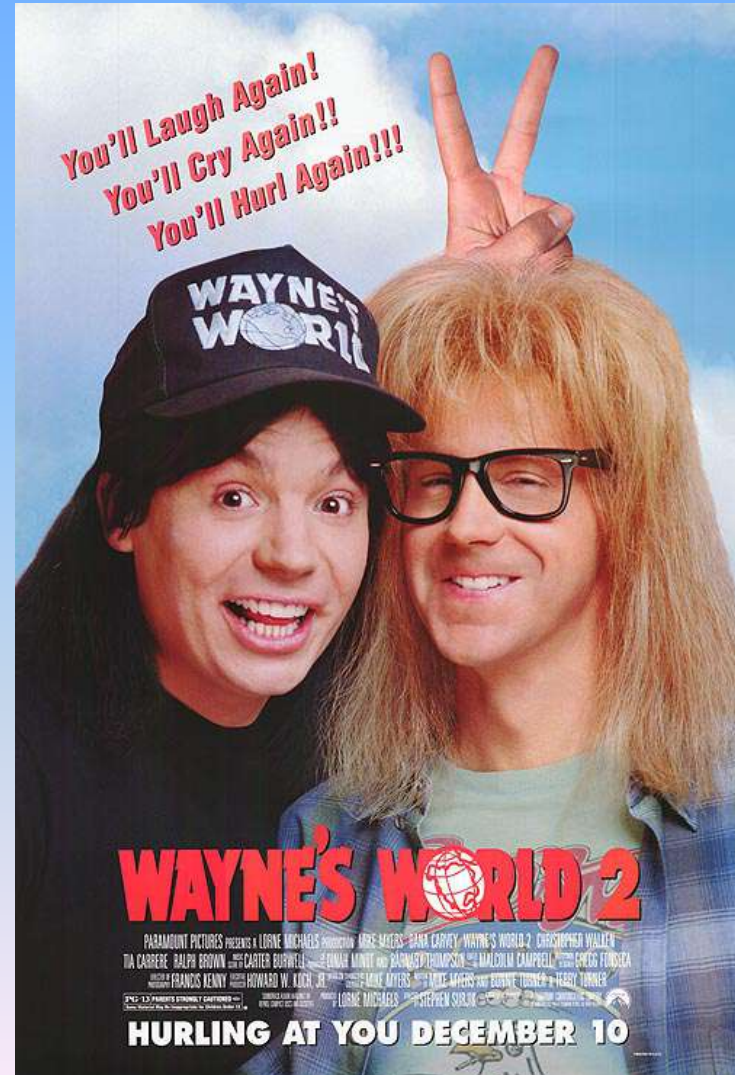
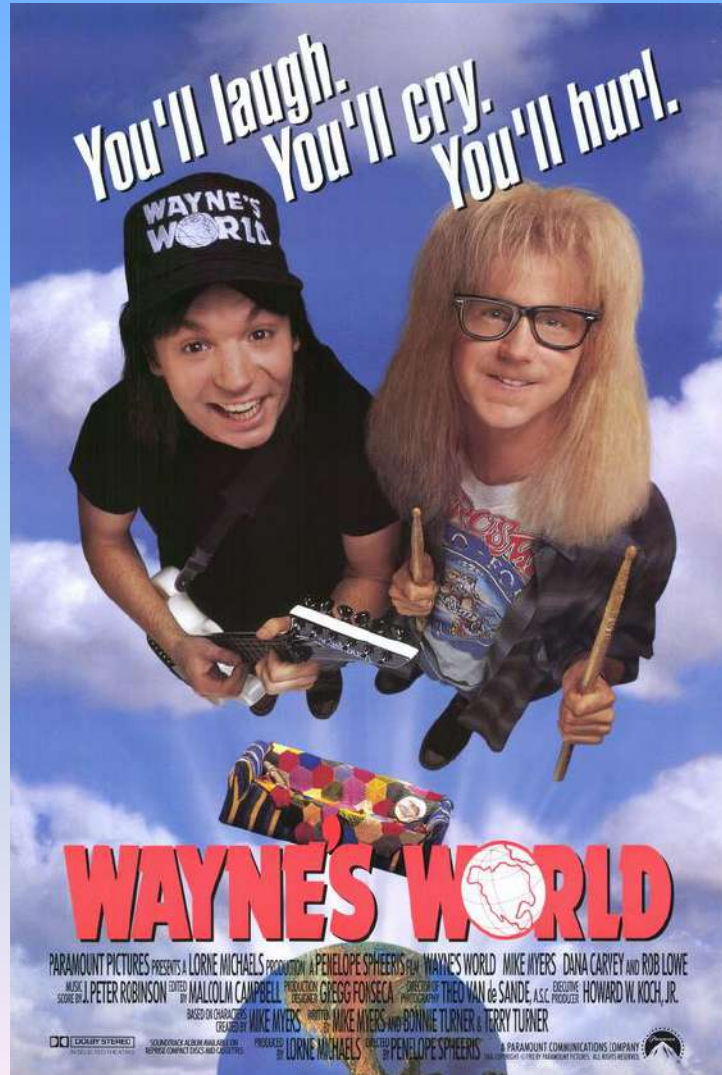


# TV to Movies 300
