This quarter, we will be listening to music from cultures around the world. We will be investigating music from countries outside of the U.S.A. and presenting to the class using Google Slides. We will work in **groups of 2** for this project.

To receive full credit on your project, you must include the following:

1. Basic information about the country you have chosen

- Geography
- Population
- Religion/Culture
- Languages
- Customs/Traditions

2. Describe characteristics and history of the music

- How has it developed over time?
- Describe musical elements (rhythm, melody, texture/tone, form)
- How and where is it performed?
- How is music taught?

3. Identify and depict at least 3 instruments

(at least one slide per instrument)

- A picture of the instrument
- Materials that the instrument is made of
- Size of the instrument
- How sound is produced (how does it work?)
- Any other background information about the instrument
- 4. Choose a musical artist from your chosen country and (select one)
 - Write a summary of the artist and their music
 - Discuss how they are connected to the music of your chosen country
- 5. Provide at least one musical example from your country
 - HINT! A good place to find world music examples are:
 - At a community library (free)
 - Online or iTunes/Spotify/Pandora (for a fee)
 - Ask me!!
