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### NARFE-FEEA SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS PROGRAM

In 1987, the Federal Employee Education & Assistance Fund (FEEA) established a scholarship program for children and grandchildren of federal employees. NARFE became a member of FEEA's board of directors in 1997, and the following year, NARFE's National Executive Board authorized the creation of a scholarship fund open to the children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren of NARFE members. The NARFE-FEEA Scholarship Awards Program is supported by NARFE members and administered by FEEA. A total of \$909,000 has been awarded to the children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren of NARFE members (as of 2014).

The competition is open to high school seniors only. Sixty winners will be chosen. Each will receive a one-time award of \$1,000.

- Must be high school seniors planning to attend an accredited college full-time in a degree program in the fall/winter of 2015.
- Must have a grade point average of at least 3.0 on an unweighted 4.0 scale.
- Must be sponsored by a parent, grandparent or great-grandparent who is a current NARFE member. (Step-parents, step-grandparents, etc., can also sponsor.) Sponsor must be living at the time application is submitted.

### Must provide the following materials in your packet:

- Official 2015 NARFE scholarship application. Photocopies are acceptable.
- Full transcript, including fall/winter 2014 grades. Report cards and photocopies are acceptable. If mailed separately by the school, must arrive by program deadline.
- Copies of American College Testing (ACT) or Scholastic Aptitude Testing (SAT), or other entrance examination scores. (Home-schooled students must provide equivalent of transcript and test scores as applicable.)
- List and brief description of any awards or volunteer/community service activities (not to exceed two pages).
- Written recommendation from a teacher or counselor, on school or other official letterhead.
- One stamped, self-addressed #10 envelope (used to notify you in the event you do not win).
- Essay

## ESSAY TOPIC INFORMATION

The essay must be typed, double-spaced, not more than two pages on the following topic: **Young people are often mentioned as a disaffected portion of the electorate because many do not vote. Why do you think so many choose not to vote? What specific actions would you recommend to bring young people into the electoral process?**
