New Google Classroom Feature for MBS parents PK-9th Grades

The MBS Technology Team added guardian emails to Google Classroom for parents of PK – 9 grade students on **April 17**. All guardians on record for each student were added.

The primary goal of this update is to provide MBS guardians of students utilizing Google Classroom with safe and equitable parent access while also improving their ability to monitor and support student learning.

When guardian emails were added on **April 17**, parents should have received an email invitation to become a Classroom Guardian to their student. The invitation was from Jason Falconer, Mountain Brook Schools Network Administrator. An example of the email is below.

When individual guardians opt in, they will begin receiving regular, automatic email summaries for each of their students. Guardians can choose and even update the frequency of the emails—daily or weekly—and can unsubscribe at any time. Guardians cannot access Classroom, view the class stream, or see other students or their work. Click here to preview a sample Guardian Email Summary.

Guardian email summaries include:

- Missing work Work that is late at the time the email was sent
- Upcoming work Work that is due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or work that is due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)
- Class activity Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers
