PRINCIPAL MESSAGE

As schools have reopened for the new year, it is important to implement strategies to increase attendance for our preschool students. Building good habits early is vital for a smooth transition to kindergarten and ensuring students are present and engaged every day. The following are resources targeted toward working with families and preschool programs to improve programs to improve attendance:

Drop Off/Pick-up

MEDICATION POLICY

In order to comply with state regulations giving medication to children in school, new policies and procedures have been adopted. These include:

- •Medication must be brought to school by a person responsible for the child's care.
- •Medication must be in original container with label stating how the medication is to be given.
- •Medication must be accompanied by a written order from the physician, signed by the person responsible for the child's care. The school medical advisor must approve it before the medication is given to the child.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SUPPORT

Also known as PBIS, this is a positive and systemic approach of teaching children expectations in all areas of the school. At Bucks Hill School, the students are RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE, and SAFE. Students are taught what the expectations are and what they look like throughout the building. They are praised and rewarded with Bucks Hill bucks. Students are expected to STAY ON THE GREEN. Ask your child to explain what that means.

ATTENDANCE COUNTS

Attending school every day sends the message that school is important – that learning is important. It provides your child with a sense of accomplishment and a sense of pride. It allows your child to be a productive member of a group. When a child stays home he or she is missing more than just academics. They are missing the opportunity to participate in a shared experience. When they return, everyone else in the class knows what happened yesterday and your child doesn't. He or she can feel left out. Children learn more than how to read and write. At school they learn how to participate in a group, how to share and cooperate with others. They learn how to solve conflicts and how to develop friendships.



Dress Code Policy

The city of Waterbury has a mandatory school dress code policy. All children are to wear collared shirts in solid blue, white, gray, black or khaki. Boys can wear pants or shorts and girls can wear pants, shorts, shirts, dresses or jumpers in solid blue, white, gray, black or khaki. This policy is more detailed in the student handbook. Be aware we have dress code violation form. After the 3rd warning of a violation, the child will be referred to the Board of Education.
