

- NGSS testing will take place on April 29th and April 30th. Only 8th graders take the NGSS test. In person 8th graders will take the NGSS during their Science classes and everybody will follow the regular schedule. CVL 8th graders will take the NGSS in the cafe from 8:15-9:15.
- SBA Testing will take place each of the days indicated. Testing will take place from 8:20 to 10:20 in homeroom. CVL students will test in the cafe. Classes will follow a 2 hour delay schedule.
- Students who are absent and miss testing on a particular day may be pulled from classes to complete tests.
- CAT stands for Computer Adaptive Test. These tests are more content based and shorter answer questions.
- PT stands for Performance Task. These tests require students to use what they know and apply it to solve longer multi-step problems or write longer responses to prompts using examples to support answers.
