What Words Should be Capitalized in a Title?

DO NOT CAPITALIZE...

- Articles (*a, an, the*)
- Prepositions (words used before nouns which usually show where something is located or when something happened)
- Coordinating conjunctions (*and, but, for, nor, or, so, yet*)
- The *to* in infinitives (as in "How to Make Cookies")

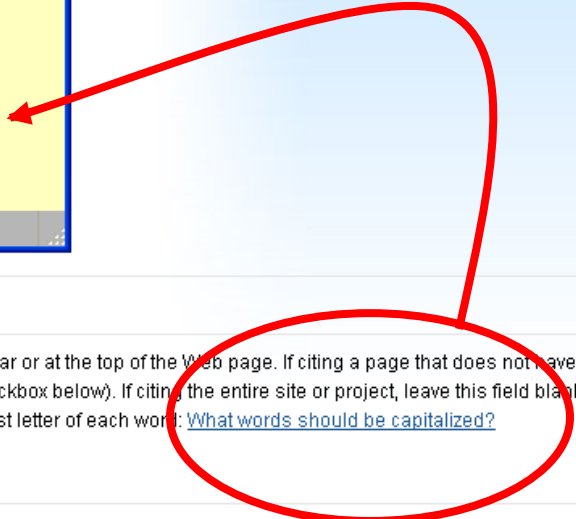
ALWAYS CAPITALIZE...

- The first and last words of the title
- The first word in a subtitle.
 - * A subtitle follows a colon, question mark, exclamation point, or period.
- All other principal words (nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives, etc...)

* Capitalize even if they are articles, prepositions, or coordinating conjunctions

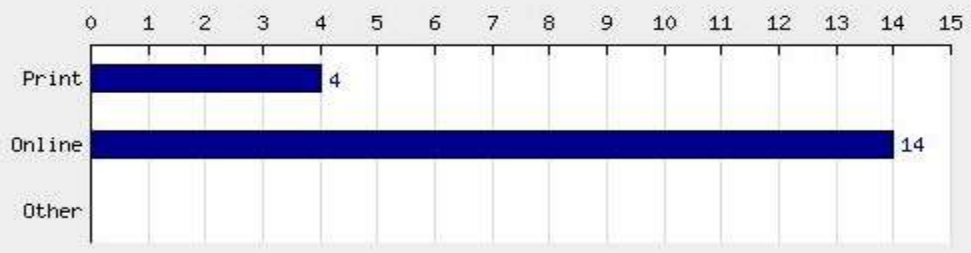

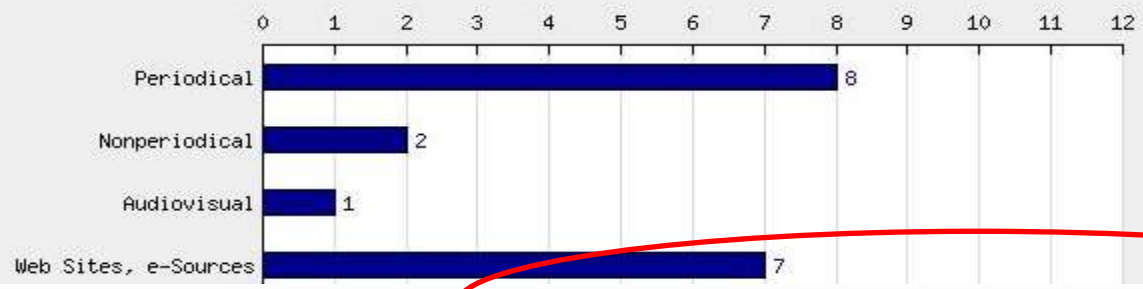
