NOTE: The UC application for Fall 2021 opened August 1st at https://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/apply.now.html. You can work on your UC application now. CSU application opens 10/1/2020. Submission period for UC is November 1-30, 2020 and CSU is November 1-30 to apply to most private universities. Application periods vary for private institutions, some have early decision by November 15, 2020 with later deadlines into January 2021. Check private institution websites for exact dates. Some private institutions may be part of the WUE (Western Undergraduate Exchange) and out of state fees may be waived or reduced. FOR ALL APPLICATIONS: <u>Do not use a TUSD issued email</u>. That email goes away when you graduate. It is advised that you choose a consistent email (gmail, icloud, etc.) and use that same email for all your applications. Once your application is received by a college or university, they will issue you an email and/or portal to check the status of your application. <u>BE SURE TO READ EVENYTHING PROVIDED TO YOU</u> Get in the habit of checking your college issued emails/portals each week to see if any additional information is being requested or if there are deadlines for futher documentation. Be sure to write down all your emails and passwords during the college application process. Remember, it is very difficult to change emails during this process and information may be easily lost or unable to retrieve if you change your email gradure an application is submitted.
