I. Early Events

A. Women's March on Versailles

II. Formed New Government

A. Sept. 1791 – assembly wrote new constitution

1. limited powers of King

2. organized new Parliament

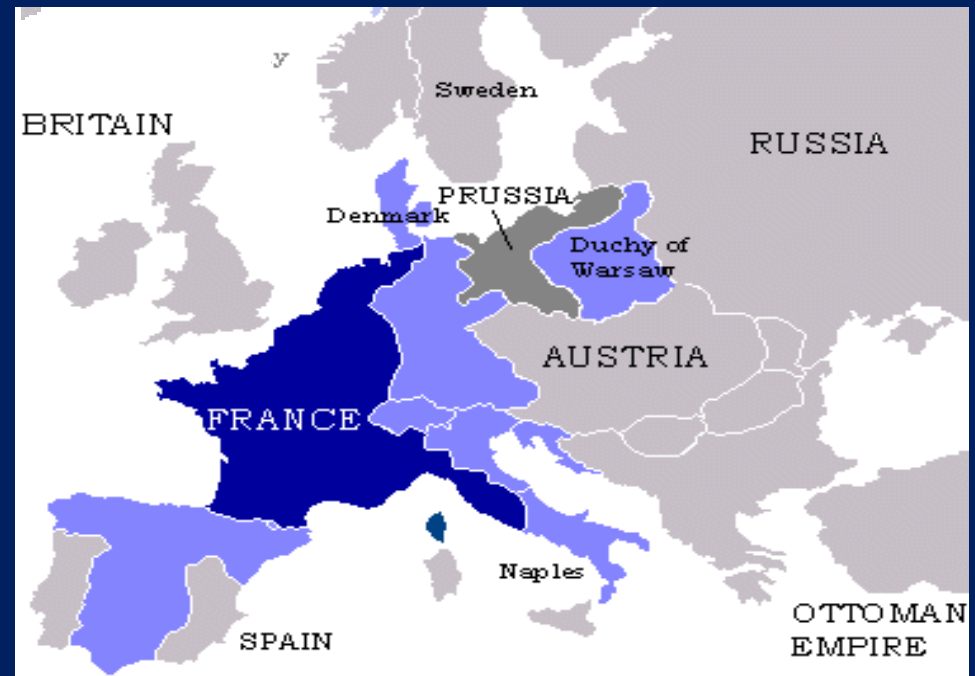
III. Attack on New Government

A. Austria & Prussia declared war against France

1. supported bringing King back to power

B. By end of 1792, Parisians captured Louis XVI and family and executed them

C. September 21, 1792 – National Convention declared France a republic



IV. Beginning of Terror

A. Marquis de LaFayette

1. led national guard against King & ruling Estates
2. jailed for not being radical enough

B. Riots spread through France

1. peasants attacked bourgeoisie, destroyed property, stole food



V. Reign of Terror (1792 – 1795)

A. Maximilien Robespierre

1. used terror to control mobs
2. created Committee of Public Safety
 - acted as judge / jury / executioner of those accused of being against Revolution
3. known as Reign of Terror
 - a. “enemies of the Republic” put to death by guillotine



B. Radicals began to fight among themselves

1. Robespierre was captured and guillotined, ending Reign of Terror

VI. New Rules are Set

A. August 1795 – National Convention changed name to “The Directory”
