# Listening skills

- Help students in grades 5,6,7 and 8
  - O recognize the importance of effective listening skills
  - identify problems they may have in listening effectively
  - O provide a challenging format
  - O test the improvement of their listening abilities
- Participants will
  - O listen actively to a variety of material
  - O learn to analyze
  - O evaluate a speaker's message
- Tests can include
  - O language arts
  - fine arts
  - natural science

# Listening skills



- Measure skills such as
  - identifying the main idea
  - O supporting ideas,
  - O drawing conclusions,
  - O distinguishing fact from opinion,
  - mastering other listening and thinking skills

- Contestants will listen to a script
  - seven to ten minutes in length,
  - take notes as needed
  - use their notes to answer 25 multiple choice
  - true/false and short answer test questions





# Giving Them Control

### Giving them Control

#### The Benefits:

- Students teaching students
- Greater communication on the team
- Students more likely to apply information
- Not one more "thing to teach" to the team
- Greater student autonomy and buy-in for the team

#### **Teacher-Facilitator:**


- Guides conversation
- Asks questions to prompt discussion
- Helps students understand missed questions
- Facilitates audio and testing
- Assesses tests for students



**Keep Listening!** 


There are time when students miss information. Remind them to start actively listening as quickly as they can. Sometimes what they hear later will help remind them.
