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- 4. Last name and page number are located on upper right-hand corner of all pages (including works cited).
- 5. Essay should be a minimum of 5+ paragraphs total.
- 6. **Body paragraphs** are written in **proper paragraph form** (9 CP = 8 sentences 9H/10H= 11 sentences).
- 7. Concrete details (quotations) are introduced and integrated smoothly= embedded quotes.
- 8. Essay has parenthetical citations for every source used in works cited page.
- 9. Parenthetical citations are included at the **end of sentences**. **Period** comes after parenthetical citation. Ex. (Chaves 10).
- 10. Essay has no grammatical and/or spelling mistakes. Check for grammatical and spelling mistakes (Please write comments/suggestions on essay).
- 11. **No personal pronouns:** you, we, I, and us.
- 12. **Commentary is not repetitive** do not use "this shows" or "this demonstrates" etc. **Commentary is analysis (not summary)**
- 13. 9H and 10H Only- Essay includes a works cited page. Works cited is the last page of the essay and is in the following format: double spaced, times new roman, alphabetized.

- 2. What recommendations would you make for improvement? Be specific.
