Attached to this note is a figure that's ready to be dressed for our Storybook display. First, choose one of your favorite book characters. Next, make a plan with your family's help, if you wish, for creating a costume for this character. Use your imagination and have fun!

Here are some suggestions for items you might use in creating a costume for your character figure: scrap materials and trims, old magazines, buttons, macaroni, glitter, stuff from the family "junk drawer," paint, felt, marking pens, cotton balls, anything goes! You will need to cut your character out when you are finished. Write your name on the back of your character after it has been cut!

After you have created your character, you will write **at least eight** sentences about him/her. Tell as much about this person/thing as you can. You may include what your character looks like, what his/her personality traits are, and anything else you feel is important.

1. Write your rough draft on the tan/newspaper print paper.
2. Have an adult check your work. Correct any errors.
3. Have an adult proofread your rough draft one more time.
4. Write your final copy on the **white** paper.
5. Remember to **cut your character out** and then write your name on the back.

Return your final copy and your character to school on Thursday, October 15.
