

How to Note-Take: World Civilizations Medieval Research Project

Once you have located the source you want to take notes from, cite it using NoodleTools.

Locate information on your medieval topic using the database *Daily Life through History* or in one of our many medieval books- resource lists located in Destiny.

FIND

Use the reading ritual to close read a section of text:

Step 1: Read with a lens- give a focus on what to look for (main idea).

Step 2: Look for patterns- categorize/group and find similarities in text.

Step 3: Put together patterns and have a deeper understanding of the text. This might help you add to the original idea/ revise original thinking

CITE

Skim through the selected text to identify which aspect of the section or chapter you would like to take notes on. TIP- *When skimming a text look for sub-headings and topic sentences. This will help you determine the main idea of each paragraph/section.*

READ

Begin to fill out a NoodleTools notecard for each one of the different aspects of information you are reading about (see reverse).
