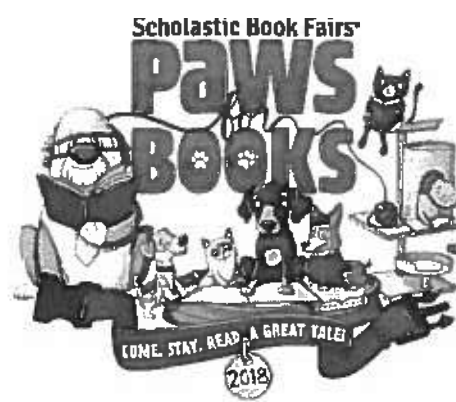

Dear Families,

I wanted to take a minute and update you on our safety and security procedures at South Side. All administrators met with the Superintendent last week and we continue to review and revise our safety procedures both at South Side and across the district. In an effort to keep all students and staff safe, the following procedures are in effect:

- All families attempting to come in the building will be required to state their reason for their visit, show a photo identification, sign in in our main office, and wear a school identification for the duration of the visit.
- Families will be required to show an ID until the staff at the front office knows who they are. Thank you for understanding we may have a substitute at the front door who doesn't recognize you and will ask to see your ID.
- We will continue to hold monthly safety drills (fire drill, lockdown, evacuation) to identify areas of improvement in our school's safety plan. After each drill we announce to the students that the drill is over and use this as an opportunity to reteach our safety expectations.
- We are asking all families to not hold the door open and let a line of guests into our school. When that happens, we are unaware of the adults attempting to enter our building.
- Bristol Police, in collaboration with the Board of Education, will be having roving patrols throughout all schools during the day.
- Lastly, as you are on our school grounds, if you see something that looks out of the ordinary, please say something.

Thank you for understanding and supporting us in implementing these safety expectations. Although it may be an inconvenience to return to your car to get an identification, the safety of our students and staff is our top priority. To address any individual questions or concerns you may have, you are welcome to join me for Principal's Office Hours on Monday, March 5, from 3:00-5:30 p.m. or Tuesday, March 6 from 8:00-10:00 a.m. If those times don't work, please call or email and I'd be happy to meet with you.
