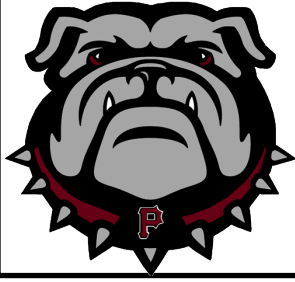

SPRING CMU CONCURRENT CLASSES

Students interested in taking CMU courses in the Spring should see their counselor to begin the process. Students are able to register for CMU courses in early November. In order to take college courses, students must meet the following requirements:

College courses must align with the student's ICAP (Individual Career and College Plan as noted in Naviance).

Students must have at least a 2.0 GPA and meet test score minimums for certain courses.

Students must be on track to graduate.

Palisade Ski & Ride Club Information on Season Passes

Palisade Ski and Ride club is offering season passes from Powderhorn Ski Mountain at the discounted price of \$199 through November 7th. After that, regular season pass pricing is valid Nov. 8th through Dec 16th, 2022.

High School Passes will not be sold after the December 16th deadline.

If a participant chooses to purchase Season Pass Insurance, the insurance amount must be included with the pass payment. Powderhorn uses contactless RFID pass scanning infrastructure. If a student already has a Powderhorn RFID Card, that card may be reloaded, otherwise a \$5.00 RFID Card Fee is mandatory for each pass purchase.

Students can get paperwork from Mr. Torfin or Mr. Steele to participate in this great deal!

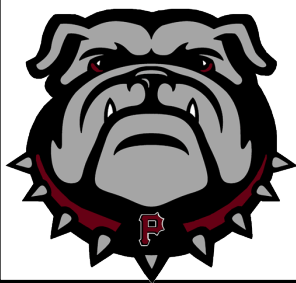
