Club Meetings:

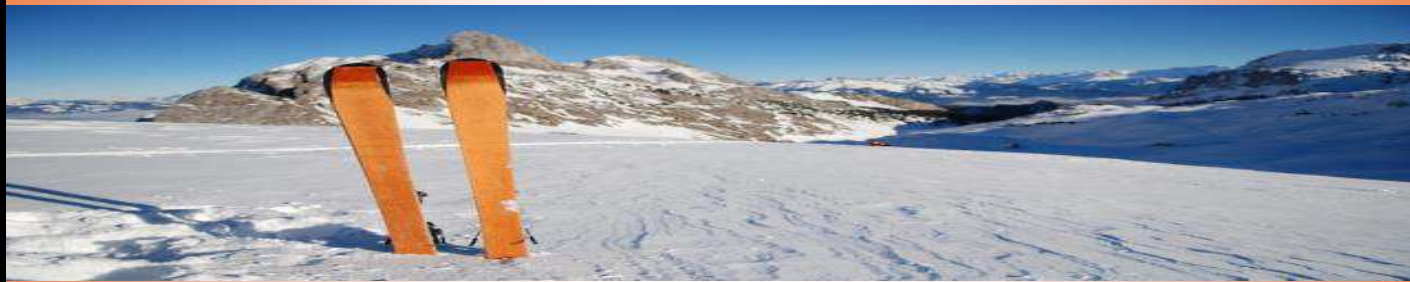

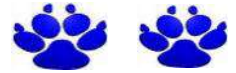

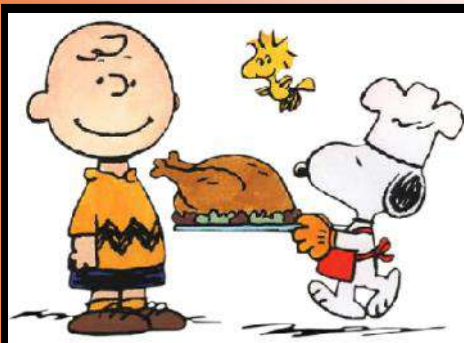
