Estamos trabajando duro este otoño. Los estudiantes siguen las rutinas y procedimientos consistentemente. Estamos practicando las letras y sonidos diariamente. Hemos introducido 17 letras e introduciremos 2 letras por semana. Pronto terminaremos todas las letras. 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Grade 1

Welcome Fall! In first grade we are excited to be back in our routines and procedures of first grade. Please check your child's folder nightly for homework, notes or notices. We do have a working snack time so when you send in snack, send in a healthy, easy to eat snack. One snack each is day is sufficient. In language arts, the concentration has been on all short vowel sounds and digraphs. Help your child to study the weekly spelling words along with the skill, such as sh, ch, wh th, ck. Change the beginning or ending consonants to make new words for your child to spell. We are working hard on correct letter formation so be sure they write neatly on their homework. We are also working on story elements; characters, setting, problem and solution. For math, we our objective is learn the partners up to the number 10. We are concentrating on turn- around facts (5+1, 1+5) and fact families. As always, continue to read with your child nightly along with completing the assigned homework in order to assist in your child's educational success. Remember to return the Friday Folders and Book Bags on Mondays!

Le damos la bienvenida al otoño. Por favor revisen el folder de la tarea todas las noches. Los niños tienen un corto tiempo para comer merienda, por favor envíen una merienda saludable y fácil de comer. En lenguaje hemos estado trabajando con las sílabas p, t, ca, co, cu, b, ga, go, gu, n, f, y l. En ingles estamos trabajando con las vocales de sonidos cortos y digraphs (dos consonantes que hacen un solo sonido) wh, ch, sh, th, ck. Estamos trabajando arduamente en la escritura escribiendo la forma correcta de las letras, asegúrense de que sus niños escriban las letras en su línea en la tarea. Seguimos trabajando con las partes de un cuento, personajes, escenarios, problema y solución. En matemáticas nuestro objetivo es aprender las partes (sumandos) de 10. También nos estamos concentrando en las familias de las sumas y resta. Como siempre continúe

practicando la lectura de las bolsitas con sus niños. Recuerden devolver el folder azul todos los lunes.

Grade 2

The teachers can't believe that the students have completed the first marking period. The students have been very busy in the classroom completing end of the unit assessments for ELA and Math.

Academically, the students completed a culminating assessment that focused on character traits. They were able to choose a book and pick a character to write about. They had to choose a character trait and three pieces of text evidence to support their thinking. For Math, the students have been progressing through their I-ready lessons and they completed the math diagnostic and the end of the unit CFA. The teachers will use this data to plan instruction for the students for small group and whole group. Also, every student must complete 45 minutes of I-ready instruction online each week.

For next marking period, the students for ELA will be working on non-fiction text. They will be exposed to a variety of media types to learn about text features and how to find credible resources. Their final culminating assessment will be to choose an animal and to create their own non-fiction book. They will use books and the internet to search for facts. In Math the students will continue to work with place value, learn about telling time, and two-digit addition and subtraction, money, and multi-step word problems.

Grade 3

The Third Grade is working very diligently to complete the final project for Unit 1 ELA. We have been working on identifying character traits in a variety of stories, and supporting our opinion with text evidence. We are anxious to demonstrate just how far we have come. We are also working hard to increase our fluency (reading speed) while reading. To this end, parents please be sure your child is reading for at least 20 minutes every day. This practice is essential for your child's success!

In math we will wrap up our first module at the end of the month. We have been exploring multiplication and division and applying these operations to everyday situations. Parents, please be sure to practice multiplication facts daily! This can be done nearly anywhere; in the car, walking to the supermarket, during supptime, at bedtime, etc... Many students do not know the facts yet, and this skill is essential! Please help your child become fluent in the math facts.

Los niños de tercer grado están trabajando de manera ardua para completar el Proyecto final de la unidad 1 de Artes del lenguaje. Hemos estado trabajando en identificar los rasgos personales en varias historias y corroborando nuestras opiniones con evidencias del texto. Estamos ansiosos por demostrar lo mucho que hemos avanzado. También estamos trabajando activamente para incrementar la fluencia (rapidez) mientras leemos. Por favor, les pedimos que se aseguren que su hijo/a lean, por lo menos, 20 minutos diariamente. Esta práctica es esencial para el desarrollo académico de su hijo/a.

En matemáticas ya para final de mes estaremos terminando nuestro primer módulo. Hemos explorado multiplicación y división y aplicando todas estas operaciones a nuestras situaciones diarias. Padres, les pedimos que por favor practiquen los factores de multiplicación diariamente (las tablas). Estas prácticas se pueden llevar a cabo en cualquier lugar, en el carro, caminando hacia el supermercado, durante la cena, mientras toman un baño, etc... Muchos estudiantes todavía no se saben las tablas y esta habilidad es indispensable para que puedan

tener un buen desarrollo académico. Por favor ayude a que su hijo/a desarrolle fluidez en los factores de matemáticas.
