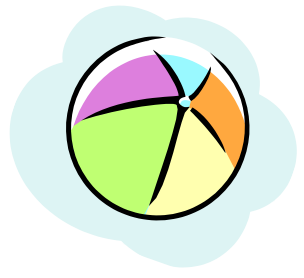




TDP Component News May & June
