


### Overarching Goals





### Comparing Carnelian with ALSD - Math



Carnelian is the top performing Title I School in ALSD in the area of Math, and is outperformed by only 3 schools at this time. 2 out of 3 cohorts showed growth, while 5th grade declined by 17%, which equates to a change of 12 students.

# Comparing Carnelian with ALSD - ELA



Carnelian is the top performing Title I School in ALSD in the area of ELA, and is outperformed by only 2 schools at this time. 2 out of 3 cohorts showed growth, while 4th grade declined by 3%, which equates to a change of 2 students.
